The board will develop the new school's charter, and influence school design. It will also appoint the principal and staff, and work with the Aranui Community Leadership

Group and the school community to further develop the community's vision for the school and the campus.

Applicants should preferably have knowledge and experience of school governance. They need to work well in a team, be able to put plans in place for the school's future, have good communication skills and represent the diversity of the school's students. The overriding focus and objective of effective trusteeship is the quality of education that the students are receiving. While applications from current members of boards of trustees are welcome, this is a volunteer position, and applicants should consider their capacity to be members of more than one board concurrently
