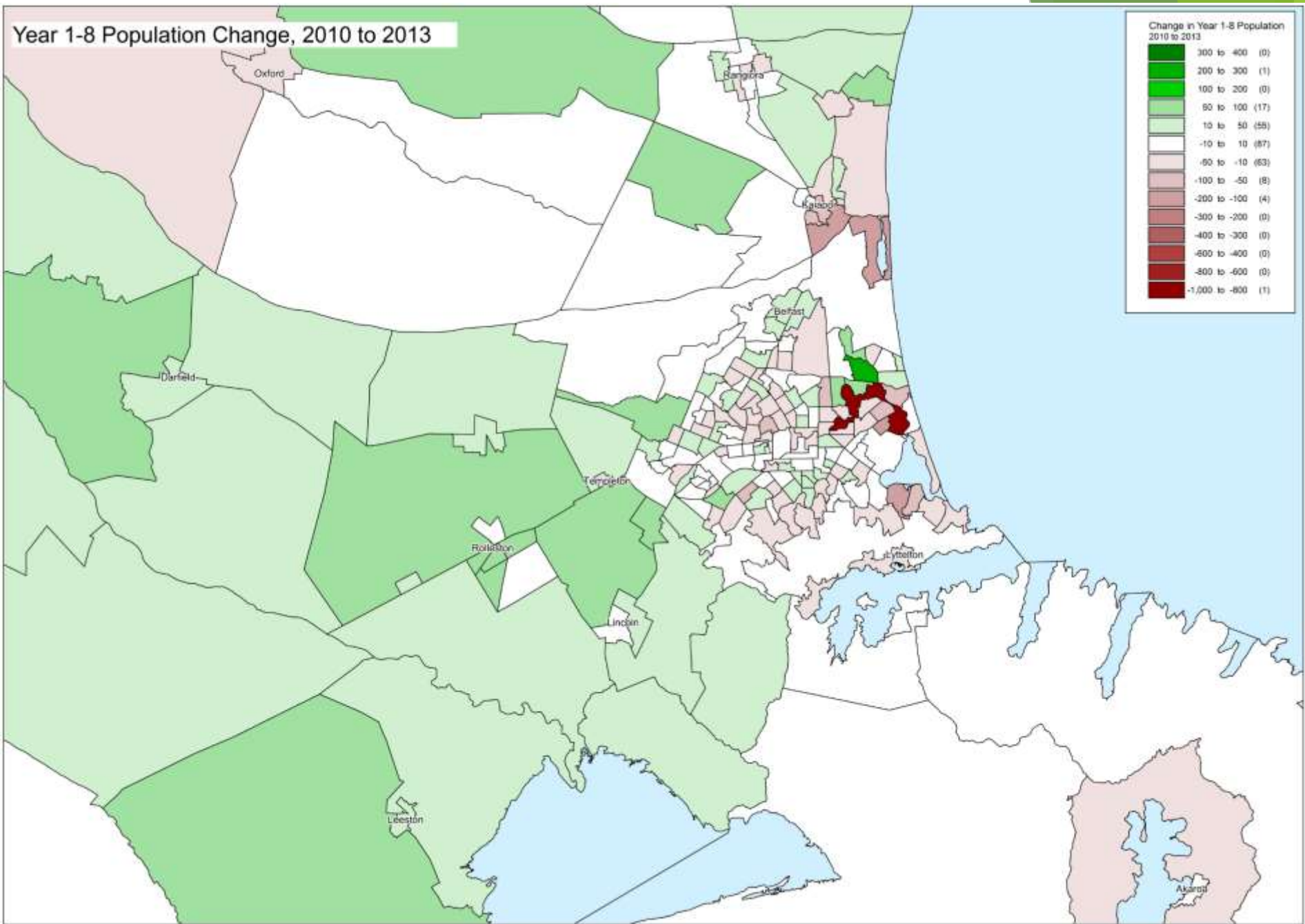


Population Change across Greater Christchurch

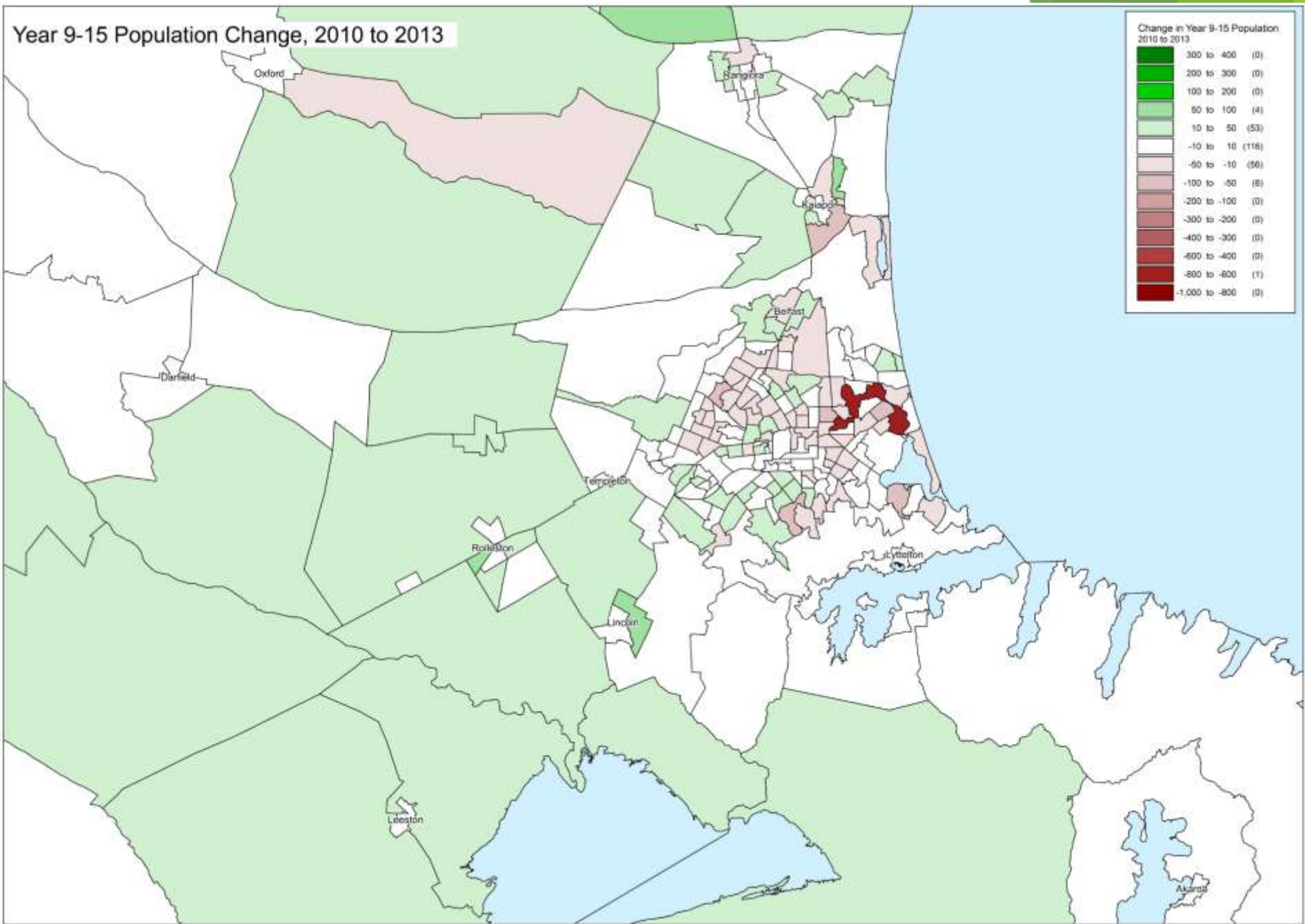
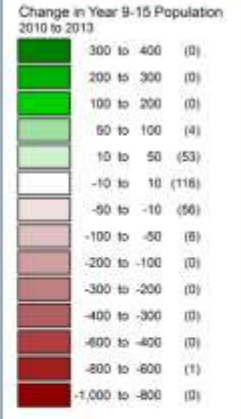
- 2010 to 2013

Note: “Greater Christchurch” refers to the combined Christchurch City, Selwyn and Waimakariri Districts.

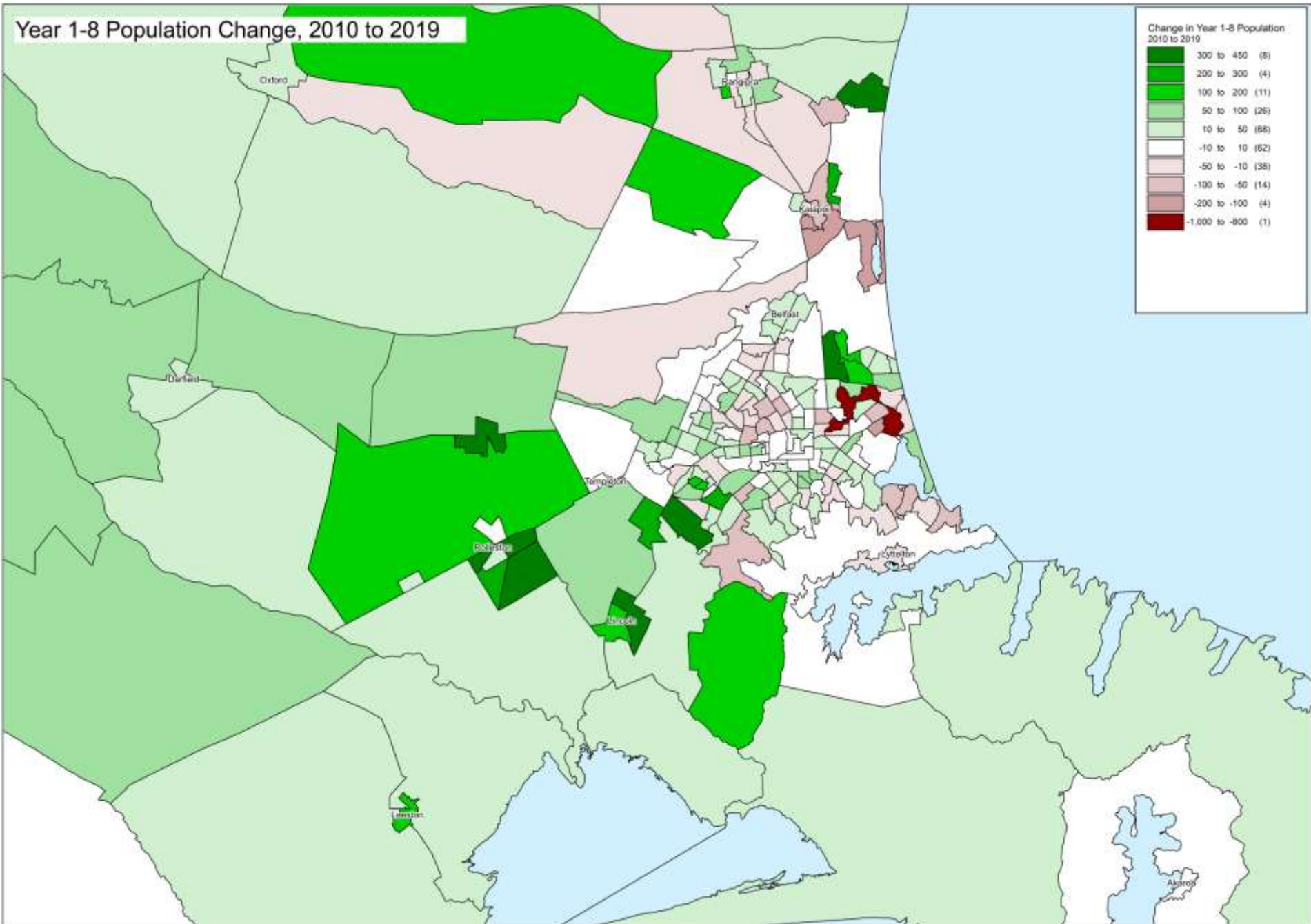
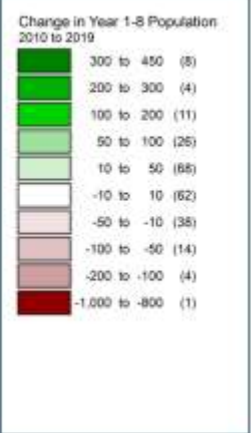
Year 1-8 Population Change, 2010 to 2013

Year 1-8 Population Change, 2010 to 2019



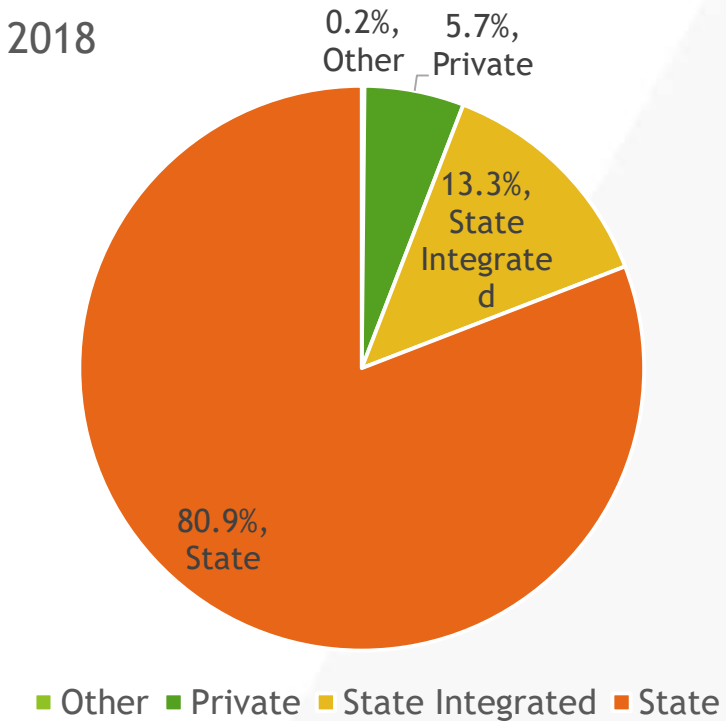
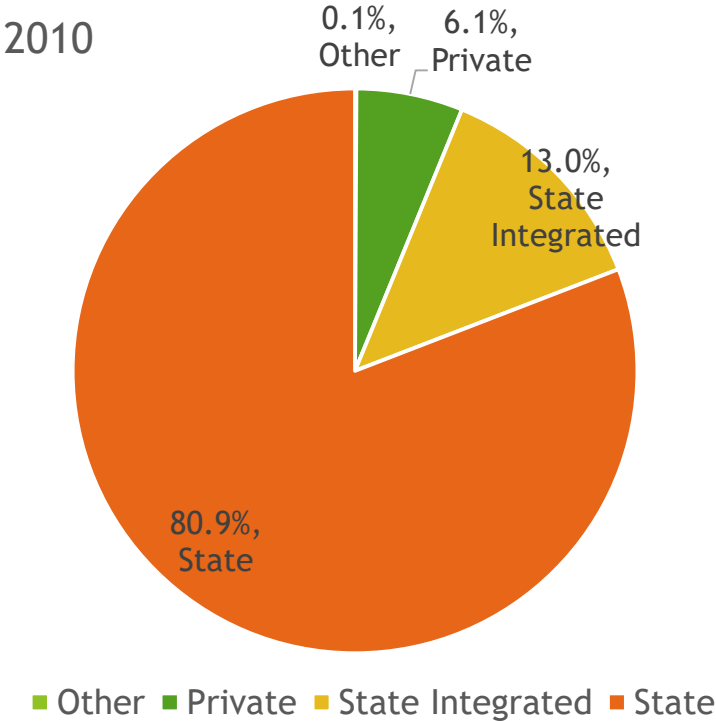

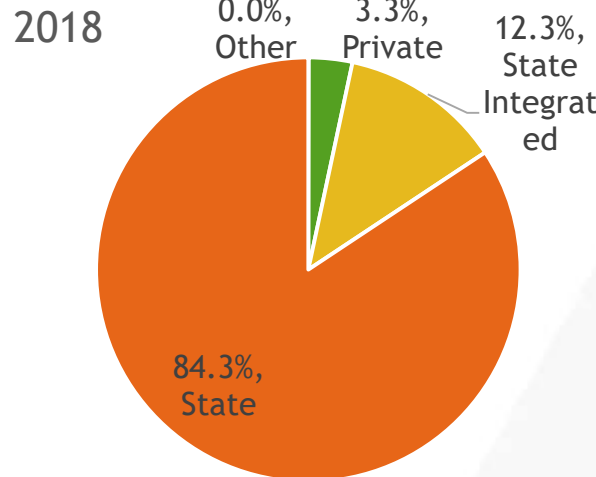

Greater Christchurch July rolls by Authority, 2010 and 2018 – all year levels

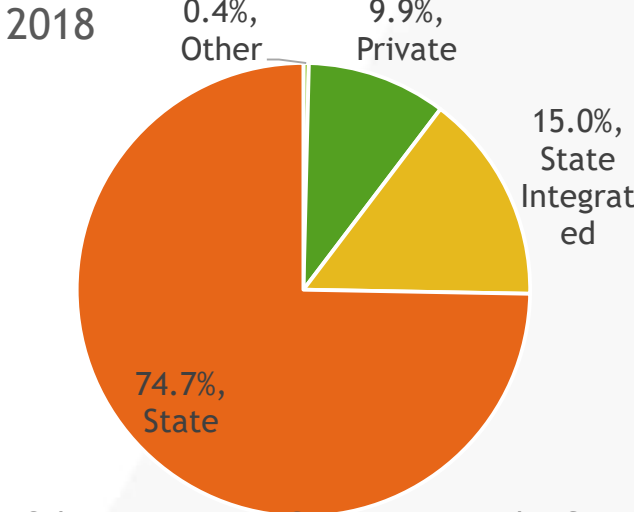
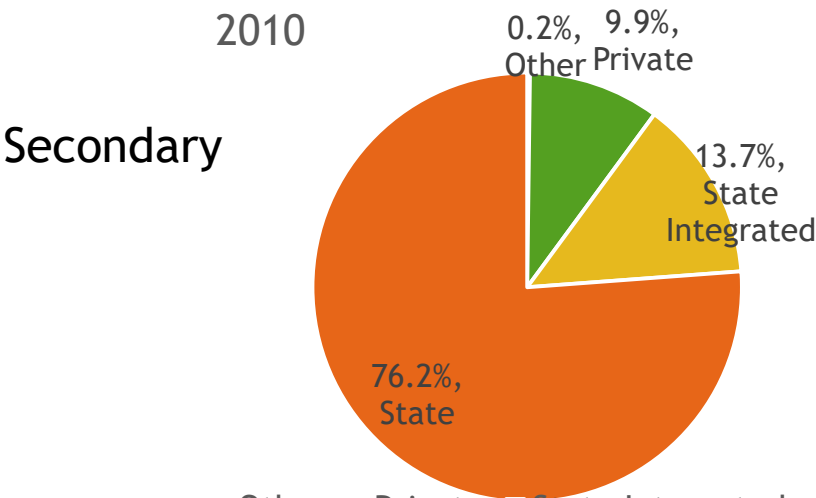

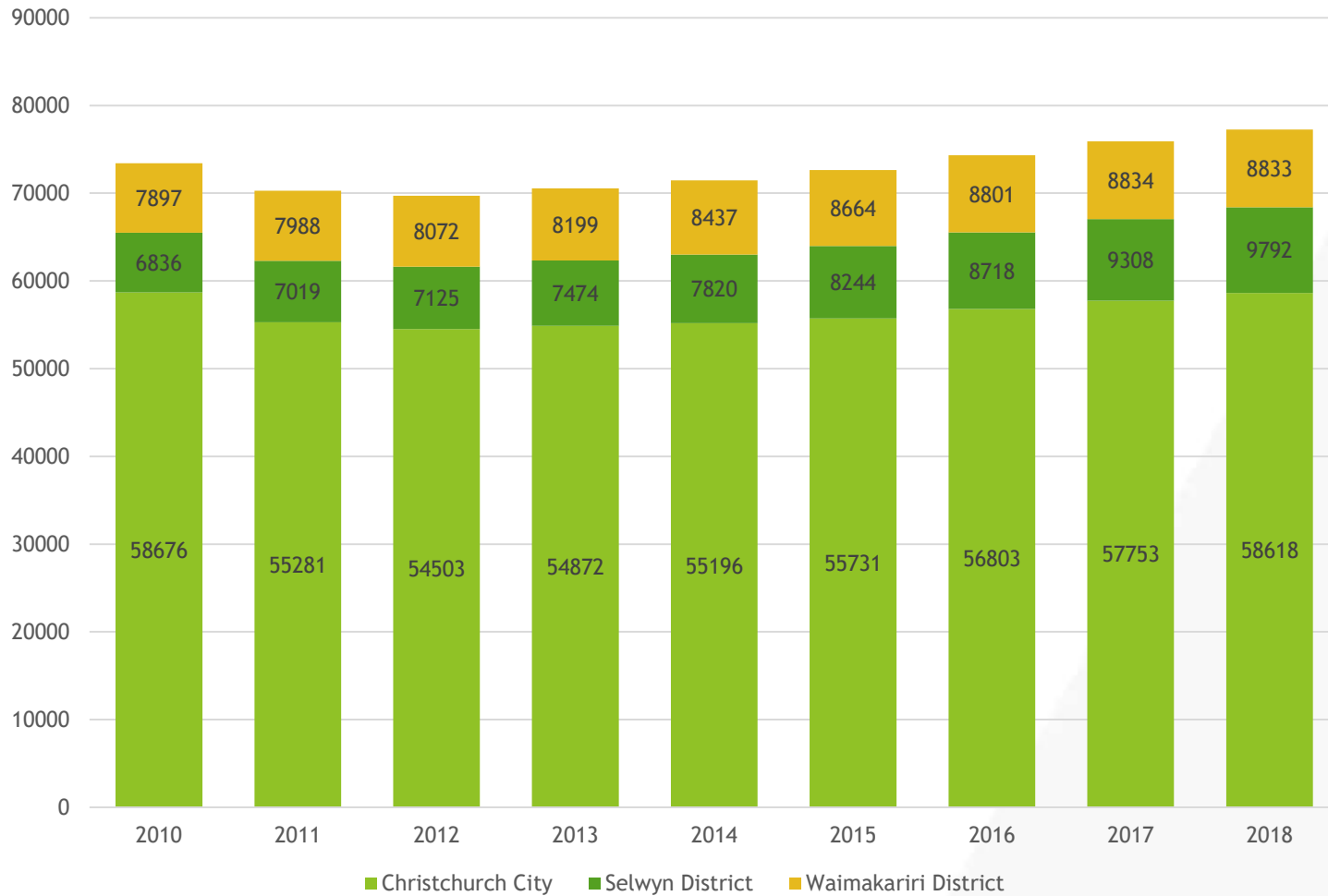

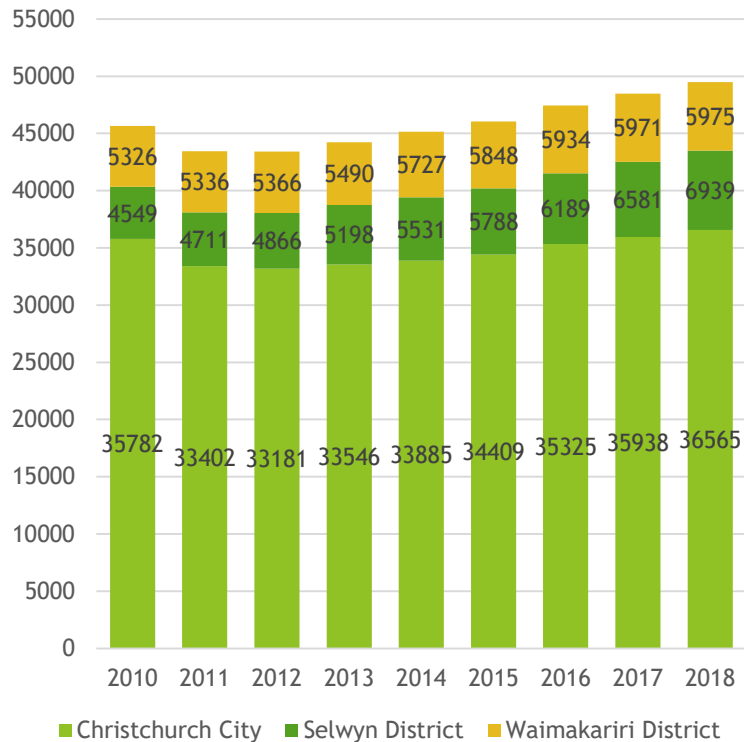

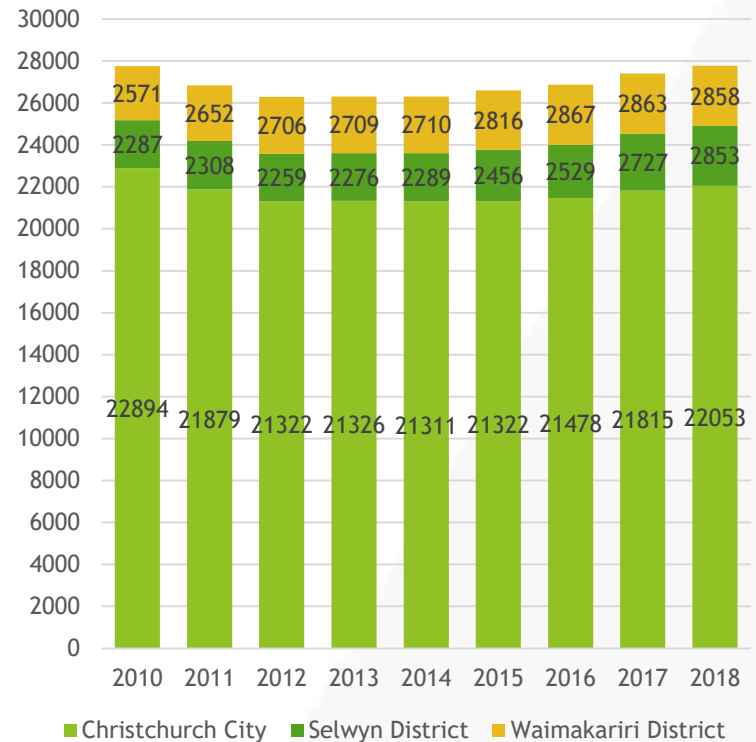

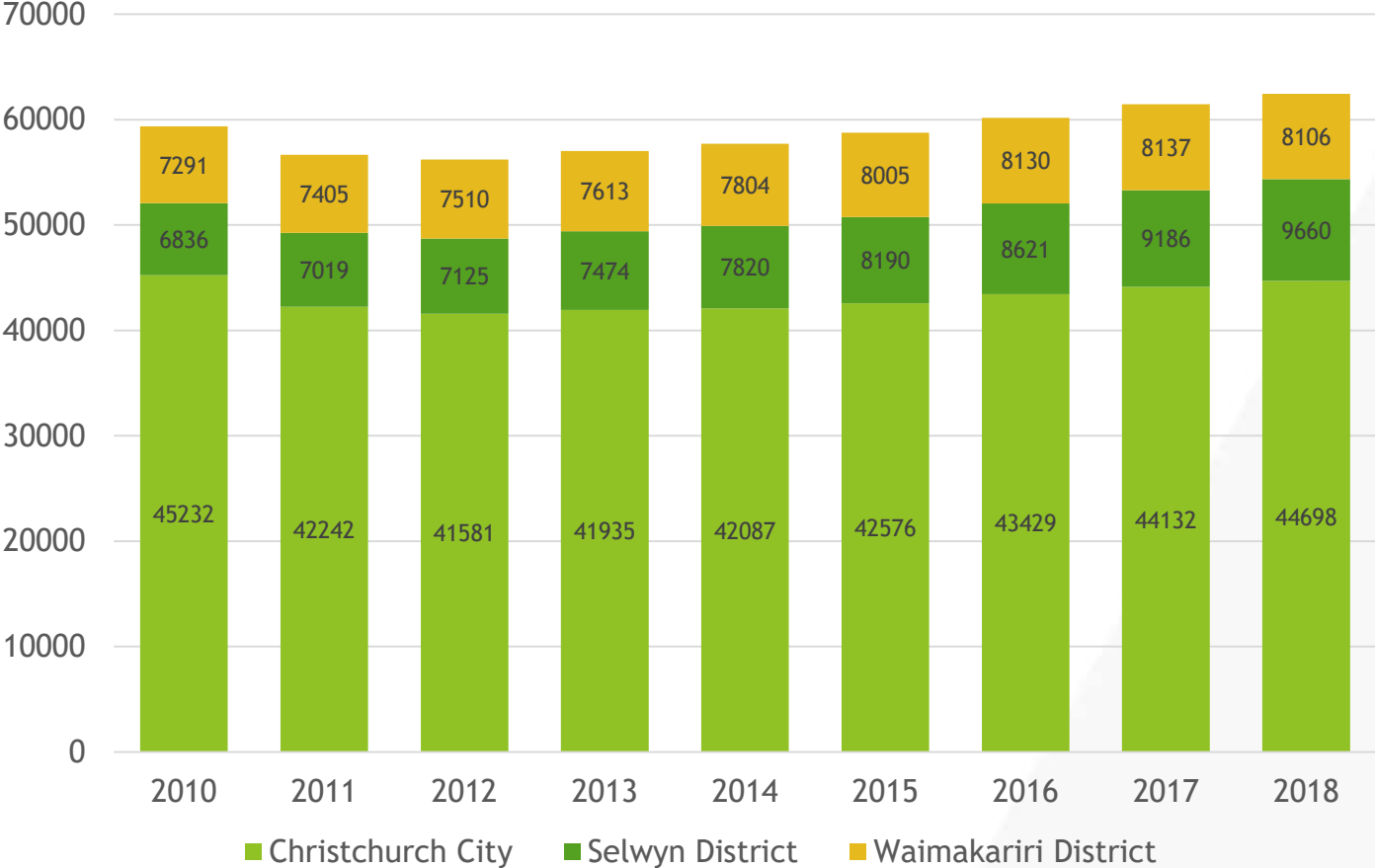

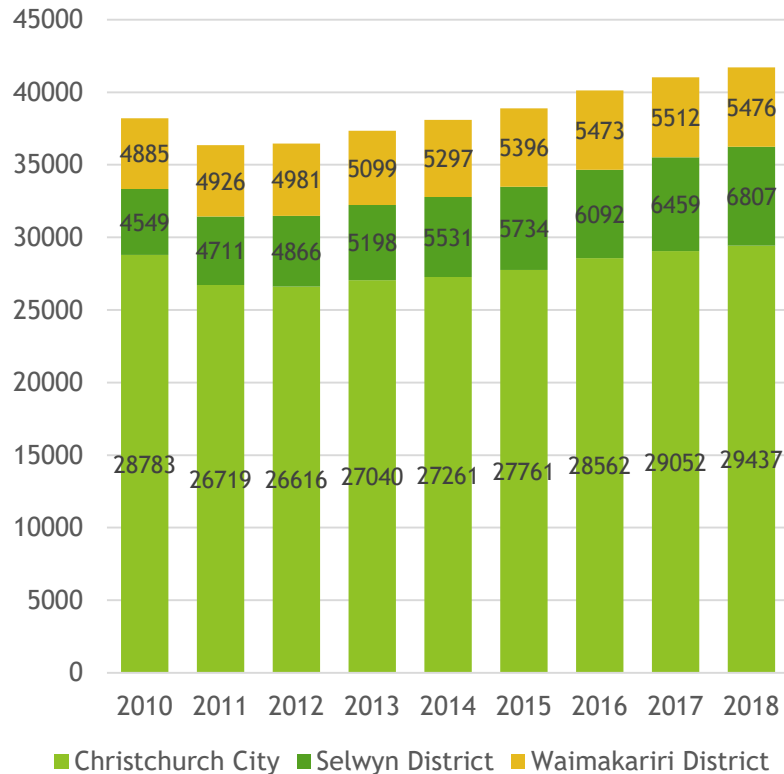
State School Rolls by District – Total Year 1-15



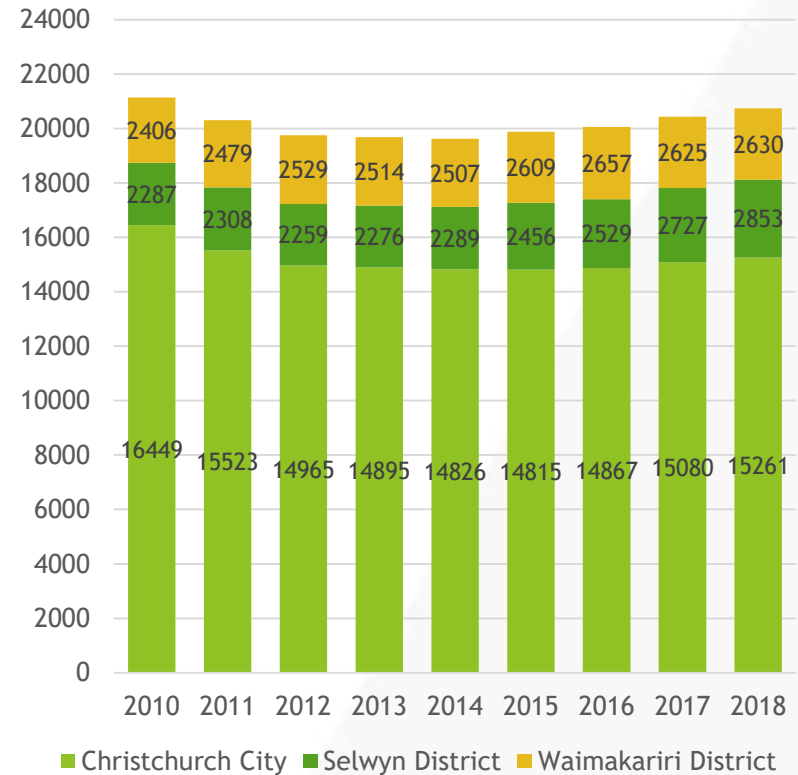

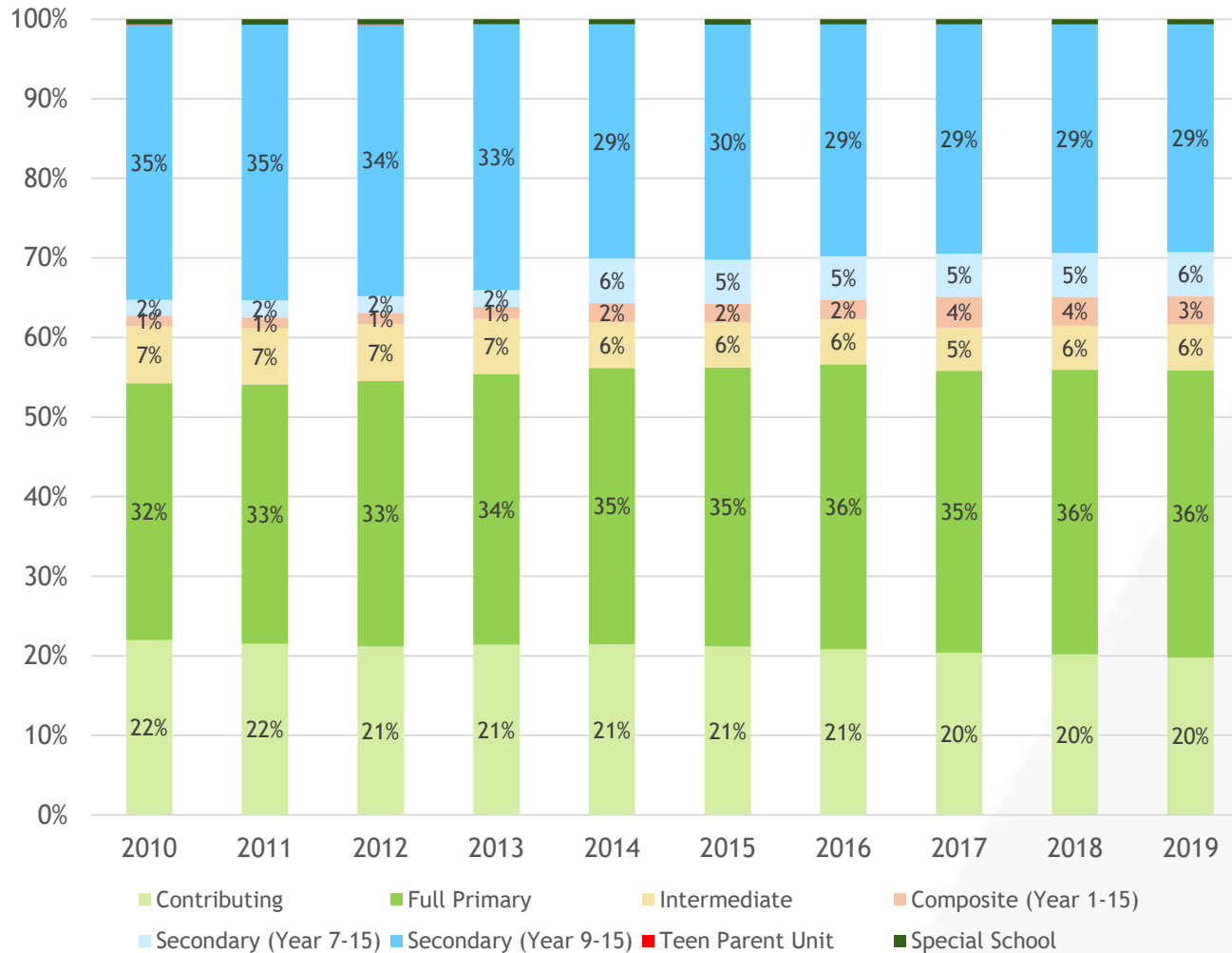

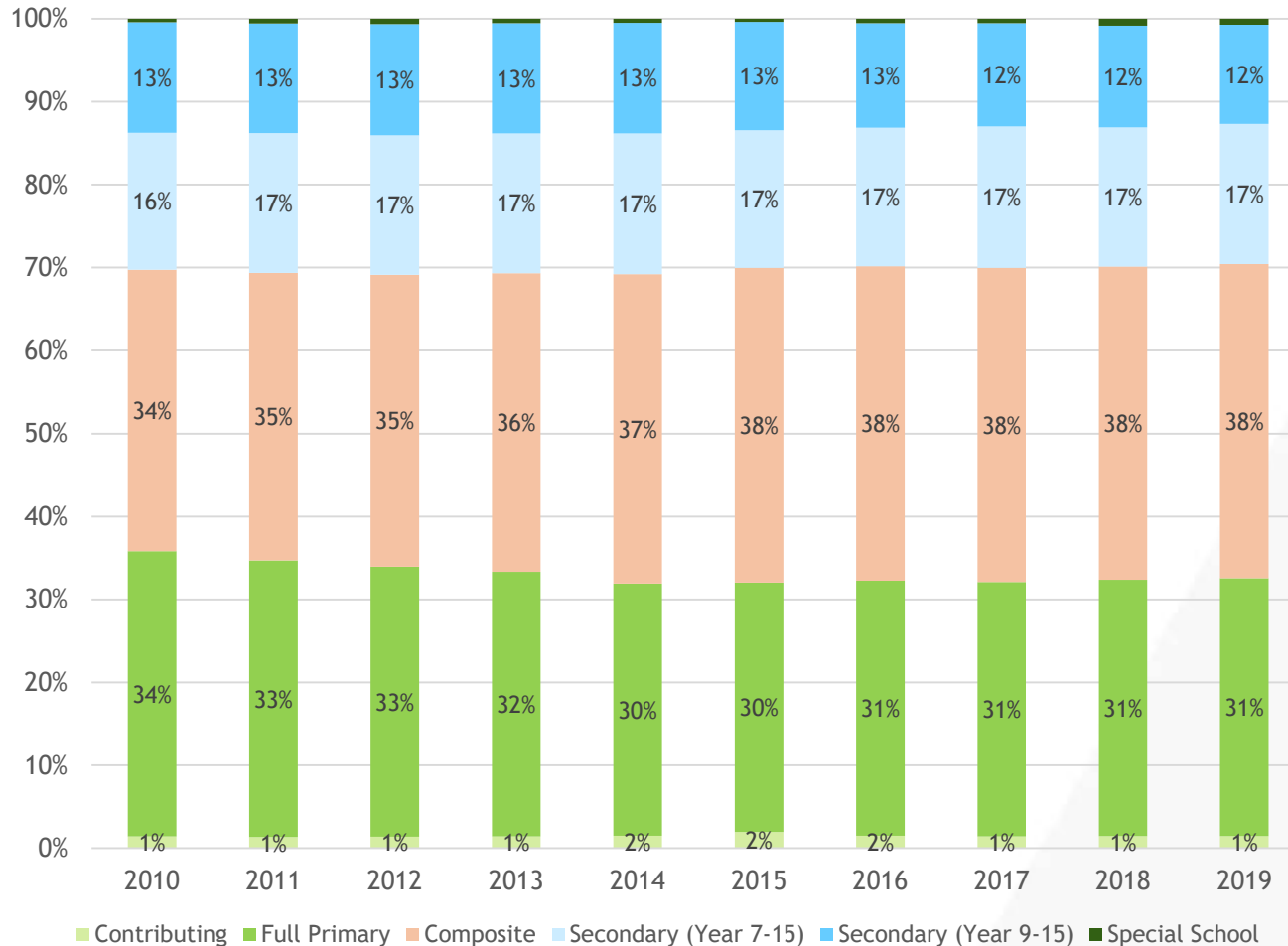

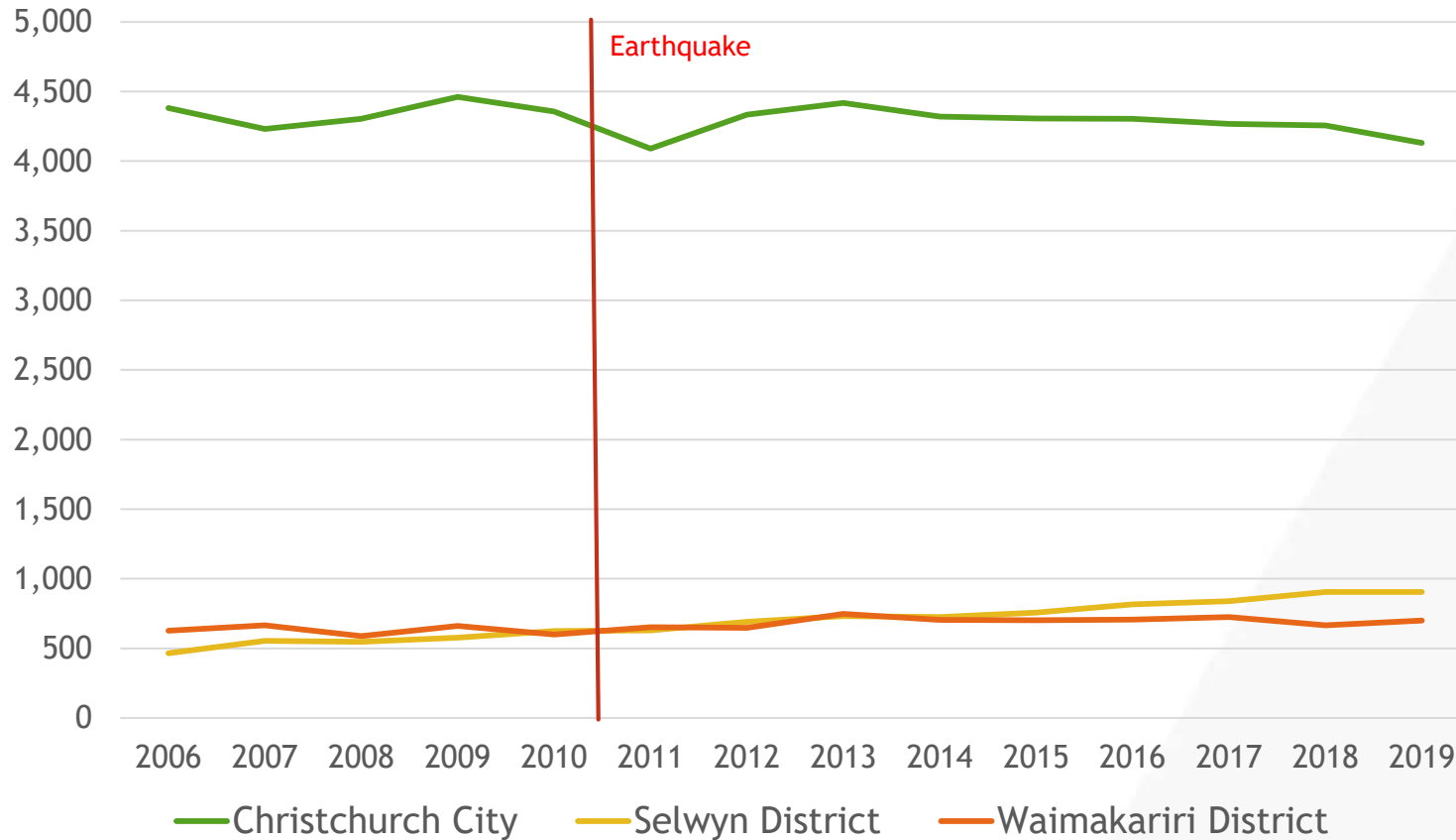

Across Greater Christchurch, a population bubble is moving through the Year levels. This varies between and within Districts.

Year 1 roll at schools in Greater Christchurch by District, 2006-2019



Between 2010 and 2019, the Year 1 population has;
Declined by 5% in Christchurch City
Increased by 17% in Waimakariri District
Increased by 45% in Selwyn District

Note that within each District there are areas of growth and areas of decline.

Enrolment Schemes within Greater Christchurch

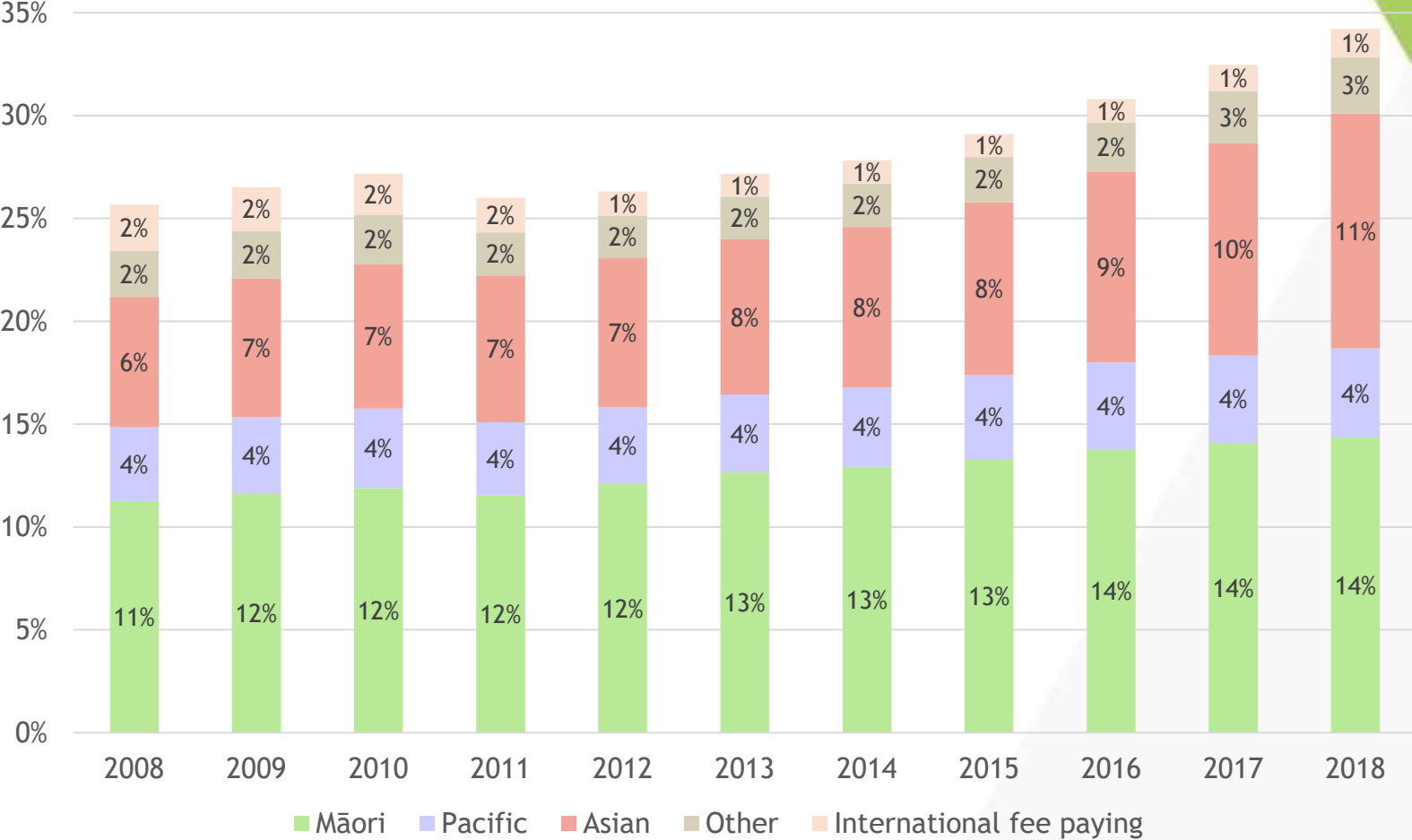
- ▶ **7** New Enrolment Schemes approved so far in 2019 - 4 Secondary Schools and 3 Primary Schools

School Rolls by Ethnicity

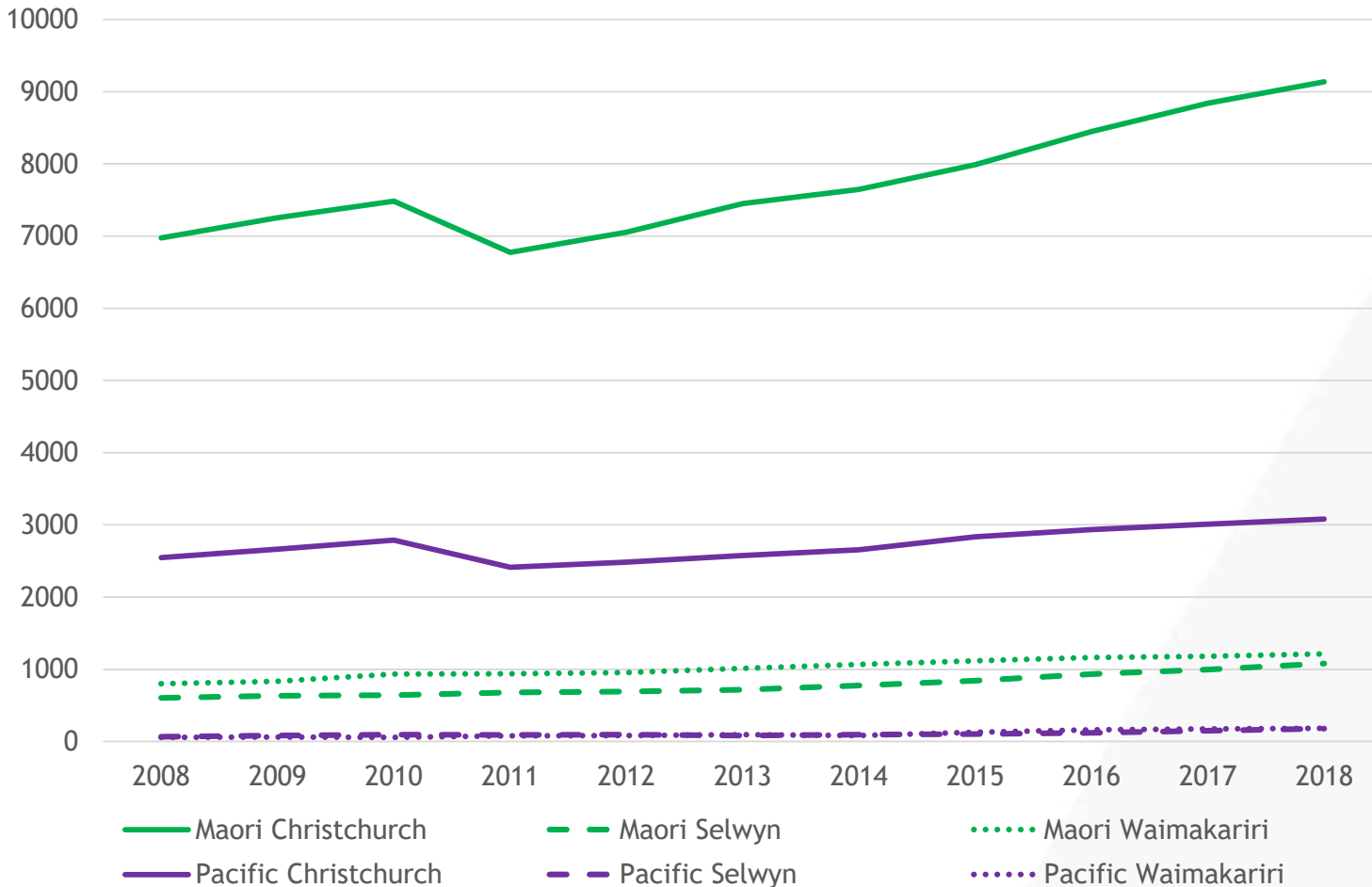

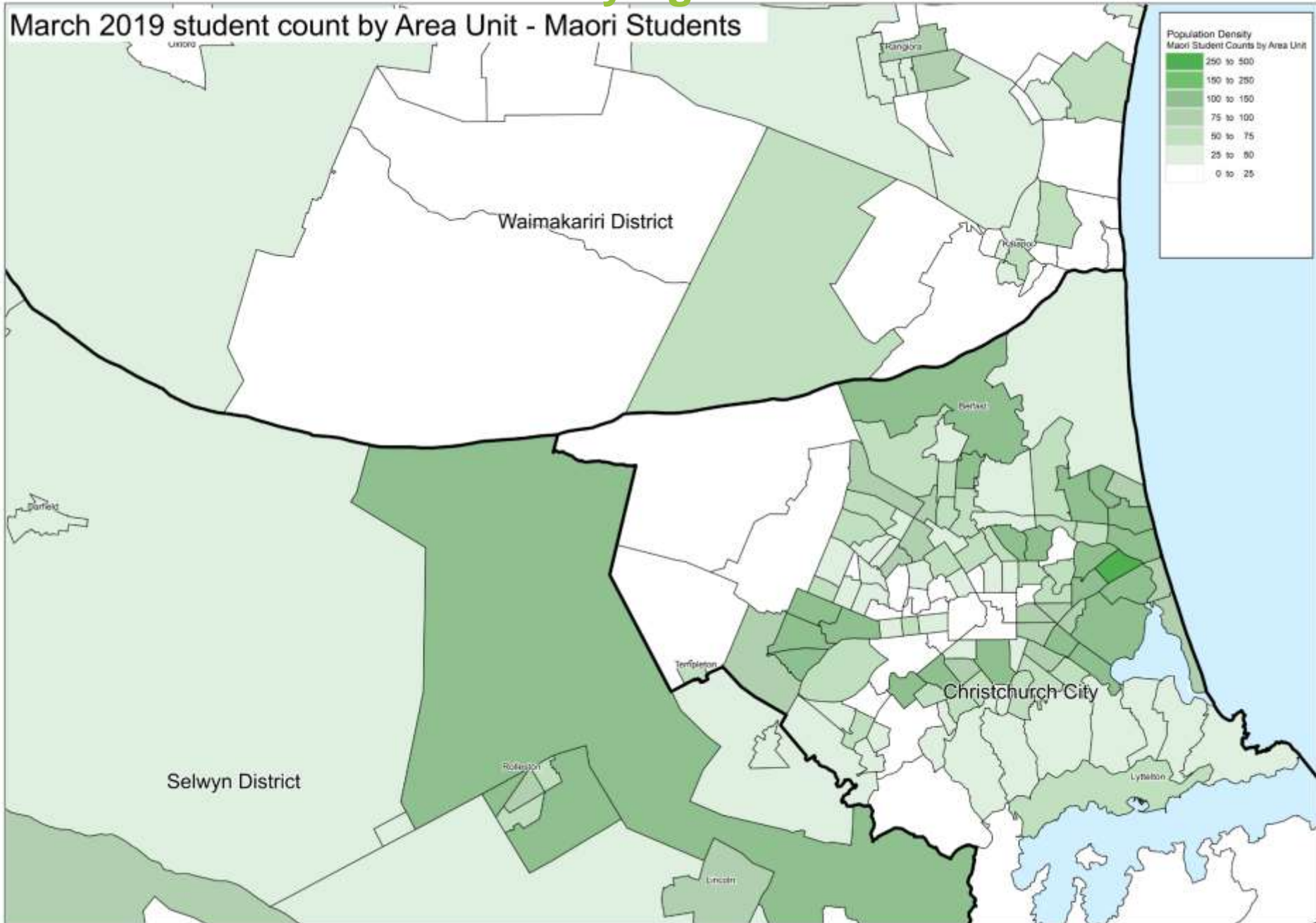

Increase in Maori and Pacific students may be due to an increase in the number of students identifying as Maori / Pacific

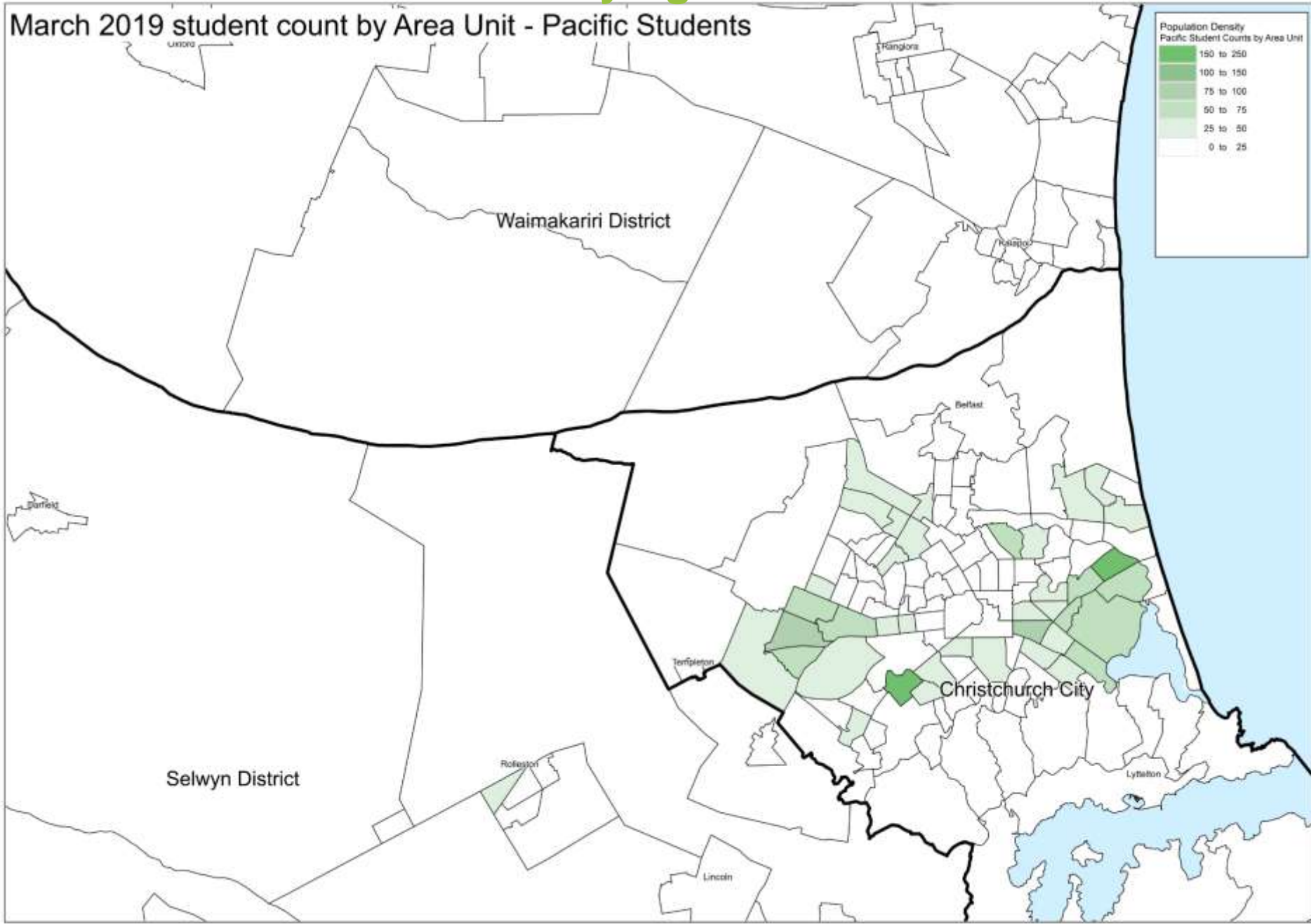
Number of Students identifying as Maori

March 2019 student count by Area Unit - Pacific Students



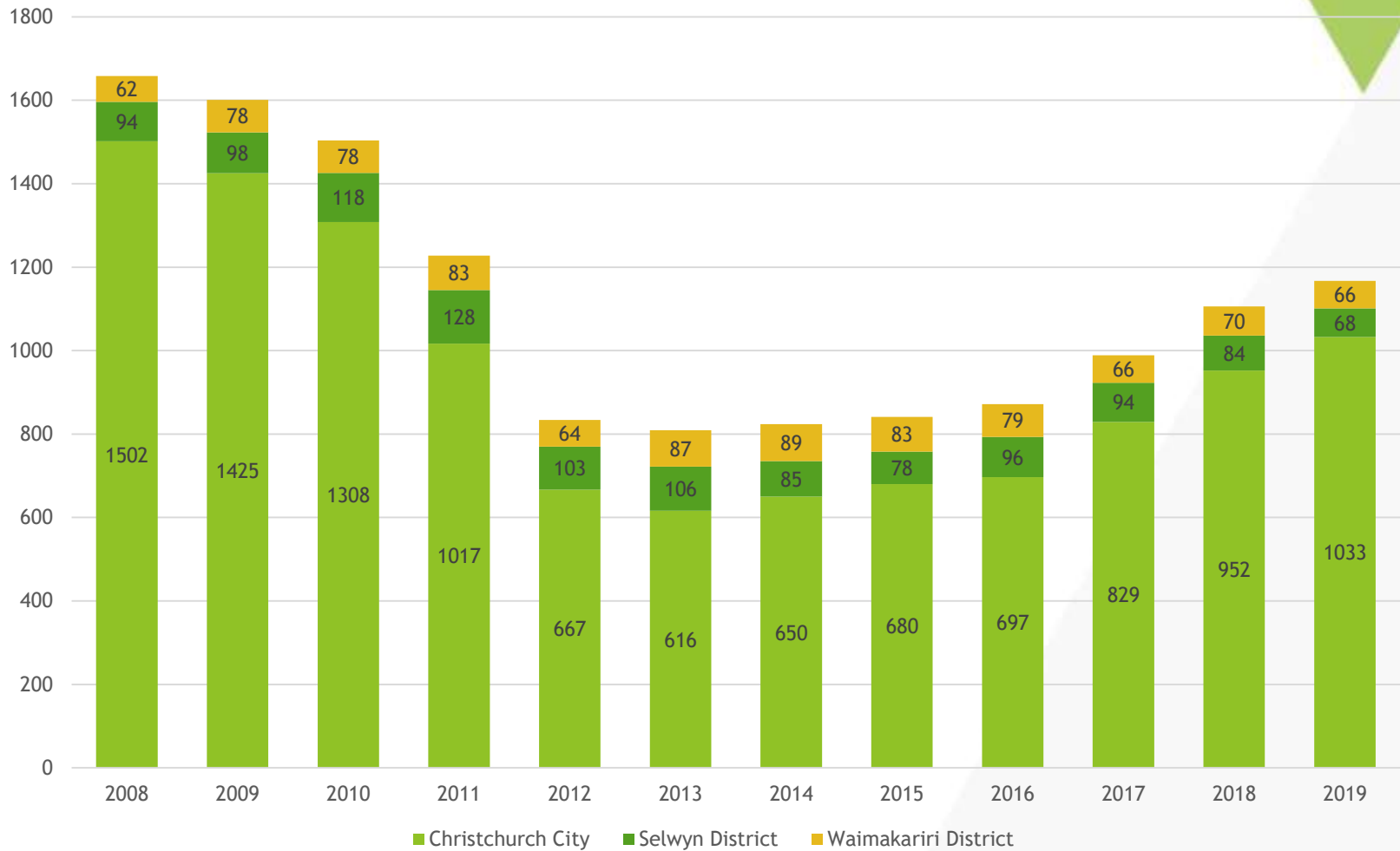

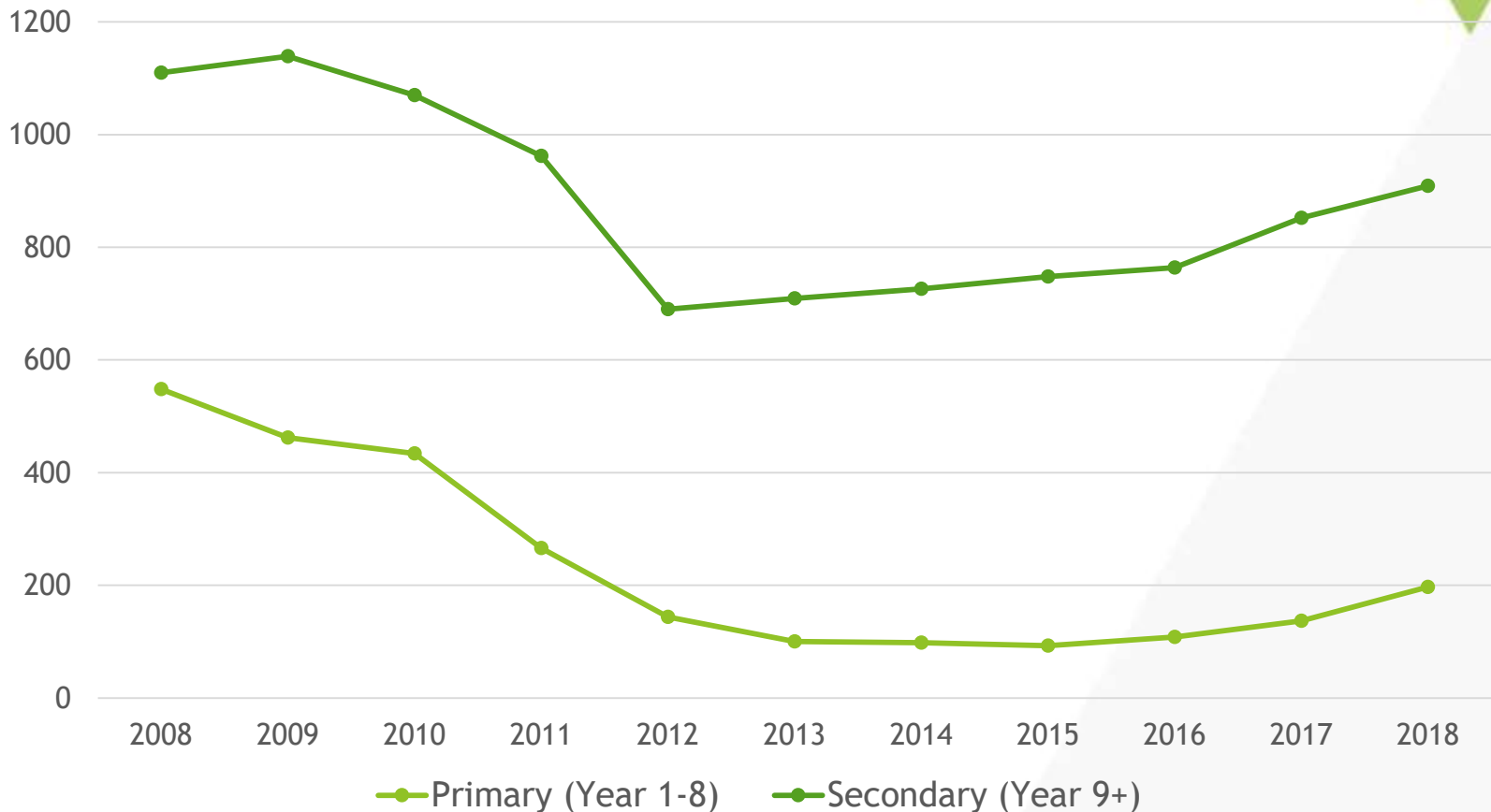
