The process to date

13 September 2012	Proposals announced
28 September 2012	Boards receive letter initiating formal consultation
November 2012	Schools in the Aranui cluster proposal given extended time to complete their submissions
7 March 2013	Submissions received from Aranui cluster schools
Late March 2013	Ministry provides advice to Minister for interim decisions for Aranui cluster schools

The process from 22 May 2013

The information below outlines the possible next steps in the process for the Aranui cluster schools.

22 May 2013	Response process begins
3 July 2013	Response process completed – response due to the Ministry of Education
September 2013	Minister announces final decision
Where the final decision is for closure and the establishment of a new community campus	
September 2013	Minister announces the date it will be implemented
September – November 2013	Consultation with Aranui schools and wider community on the options for Year 1–13 schooling provision
February 2014	Minister announces decision on schooling options
February 2014	Establishment of new school/s gazetted
Term 2 2014	Establishment Board of Trustees appointed
