






Population Change across Greater Christchurch


- > 2010 to 2013

Note: "Greater Christchurch" refers to the combined Christchurch City, Selwyn and Waimakariri Districts.













Greater Christchurch July rolls by Authority, 2010 and 2018 – Primary and Secondary









State School Rolls by District – Total Year 1-15





State School Rolls by School Type





Across Greater Christchurch, a population bubble is moving through the Year levels. This varies between and within Districts.

Year 1 roll at schools in Greater Christchurch by District, 2006-2019



Between 2010 and 2019, the Year 1 population has;

- Declined by 5% in Christchurch City
- Increased by 17% in Waimakariri District
- Increased by 45% in Selwyn District

Note that within each District there are areas of growth and areas of decline.


Enrolment Schemes work in 2019 within Greater Christchurch

- 7 new Enrolment Schemes approved so far in 2019 4 Secondary Schools and 3 Primary Schools
- 6 Enrolment Scheme amendments approved so far in 2019 3 Secondary Schools and 3 Primary Schools
- Currently engaged with 17 schools regarding new Schemes or amendments to existing Schemes


School Rolls by Ethnicity




