Population Change across Greater Christchurch

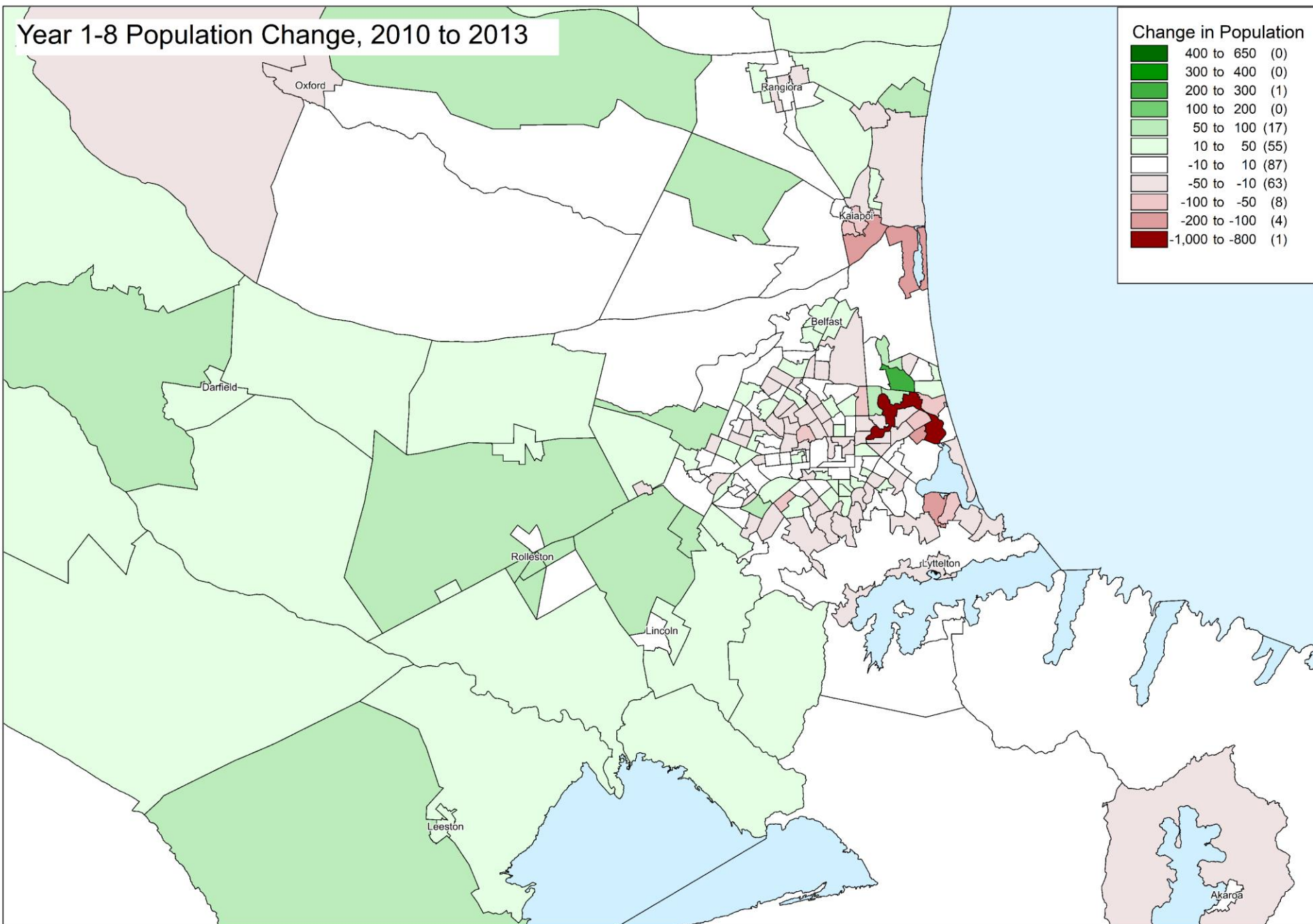
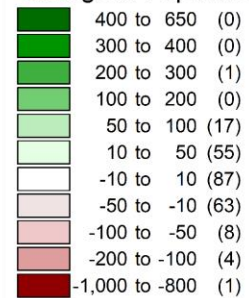
- 2010 to 2013

Note: “Greater Christchurch” refers to the combined Christchurch City, Selwyn and Waimakariri Districts.



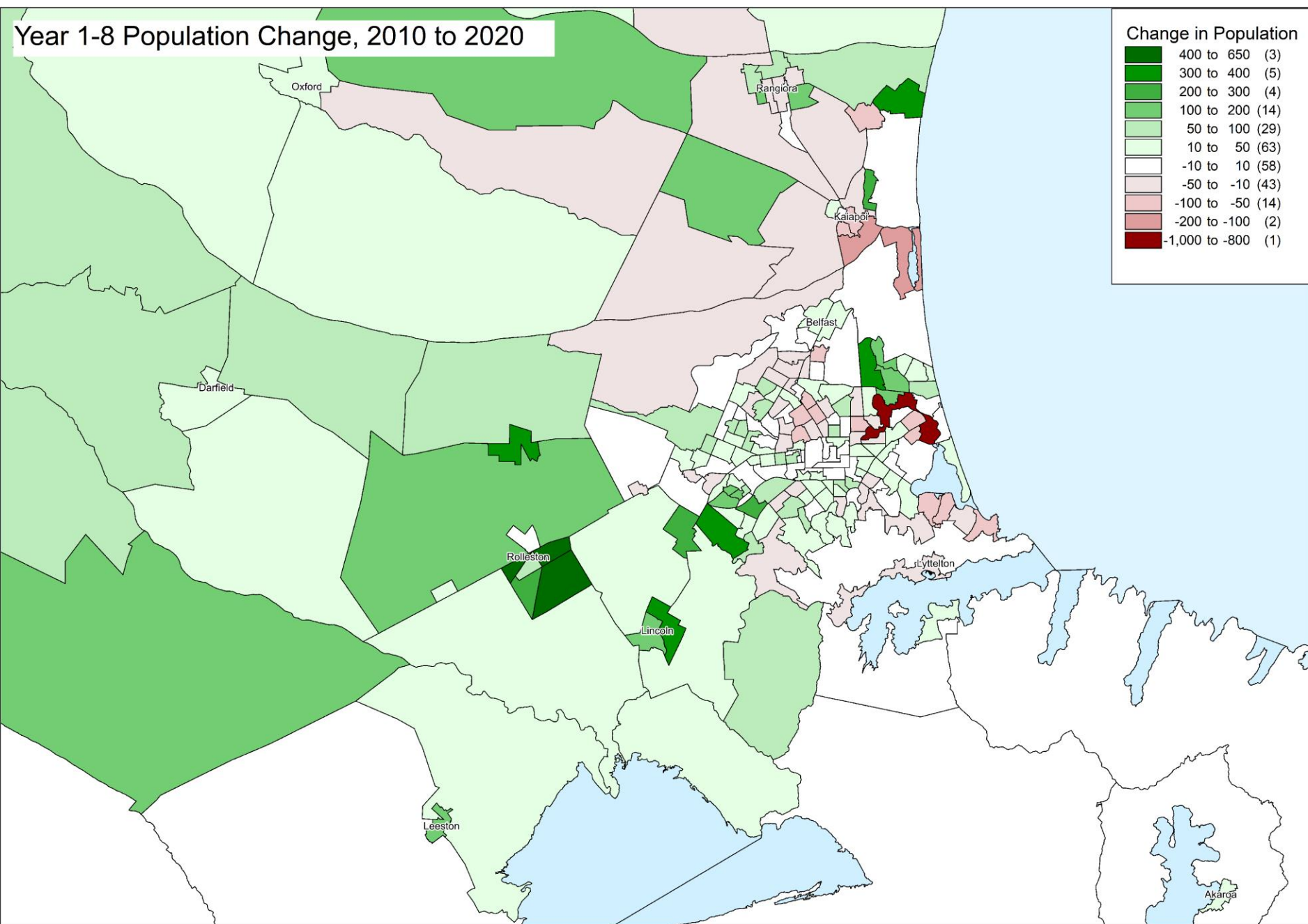
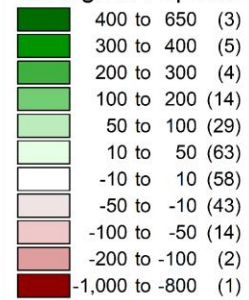
Year 1-8 Population Change, 2010 to 2013

Change in Population



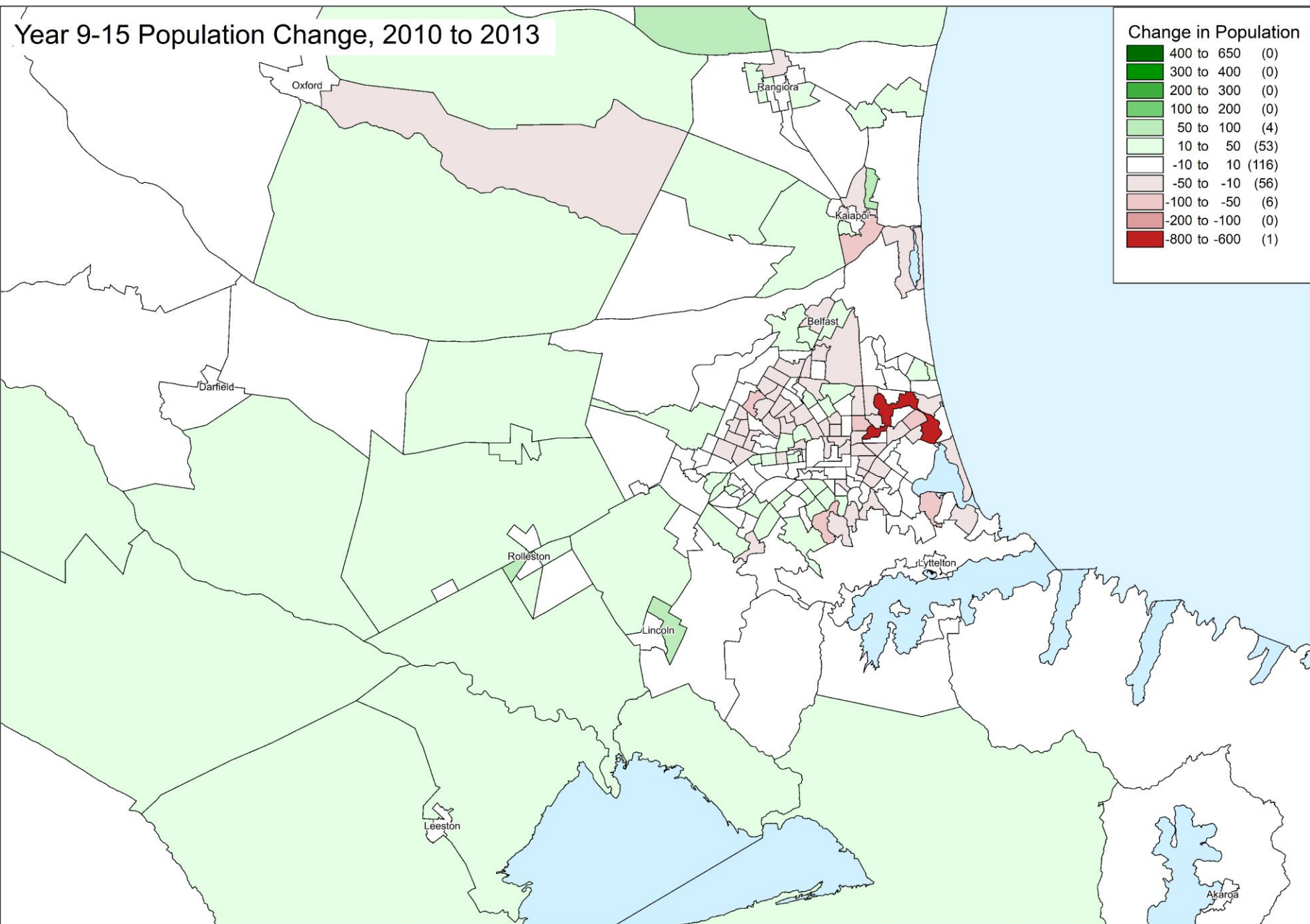
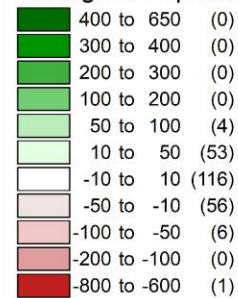
Year 1-8 Population Change, 2010 to 2020

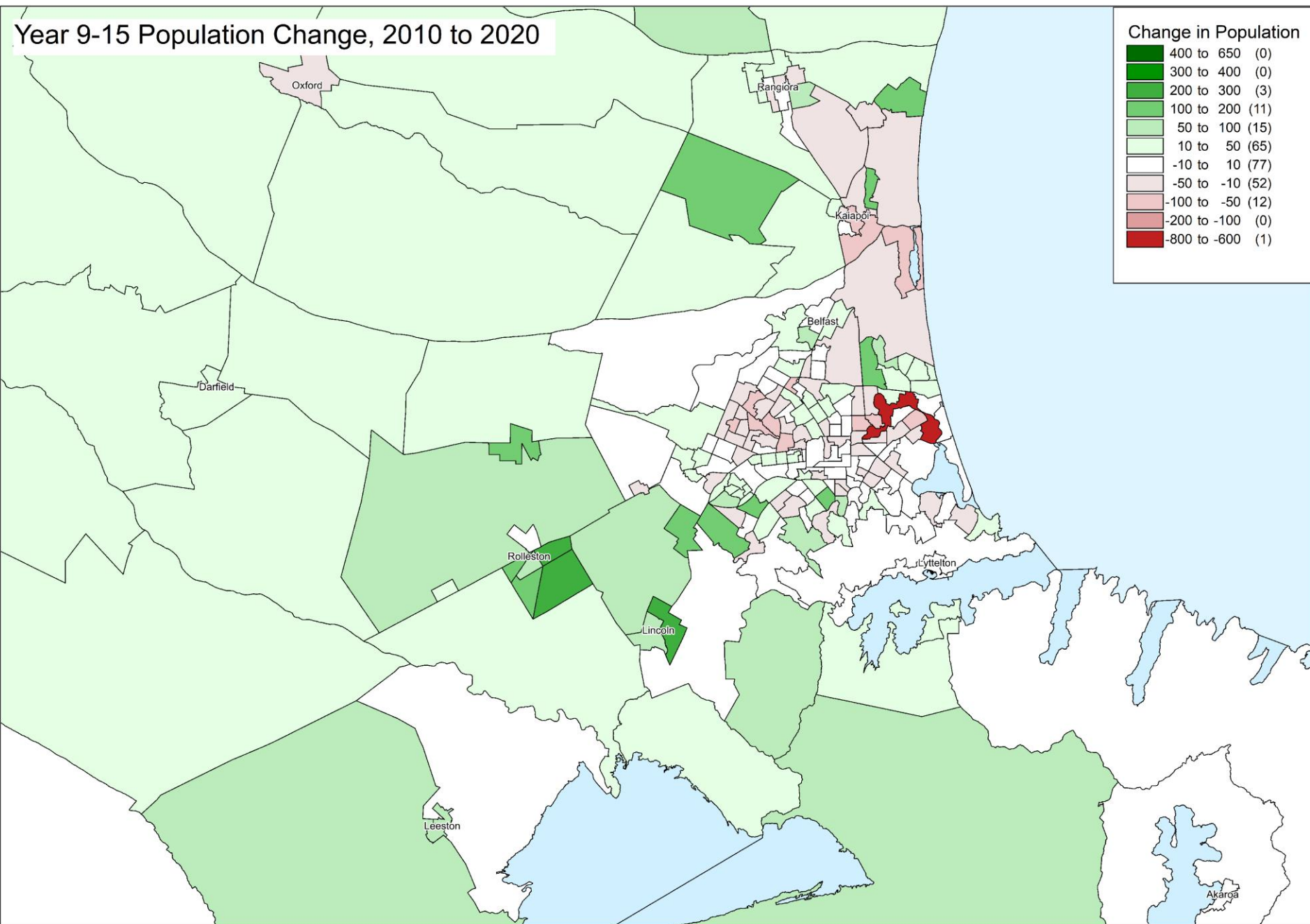
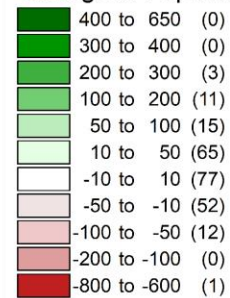
Year 9-15 Population Change, 2010 to 2013

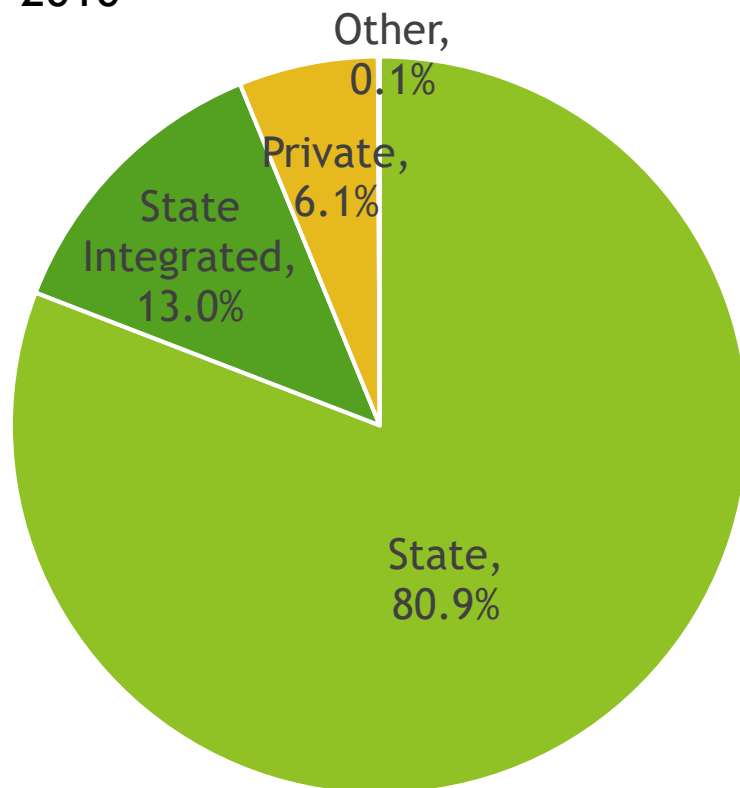

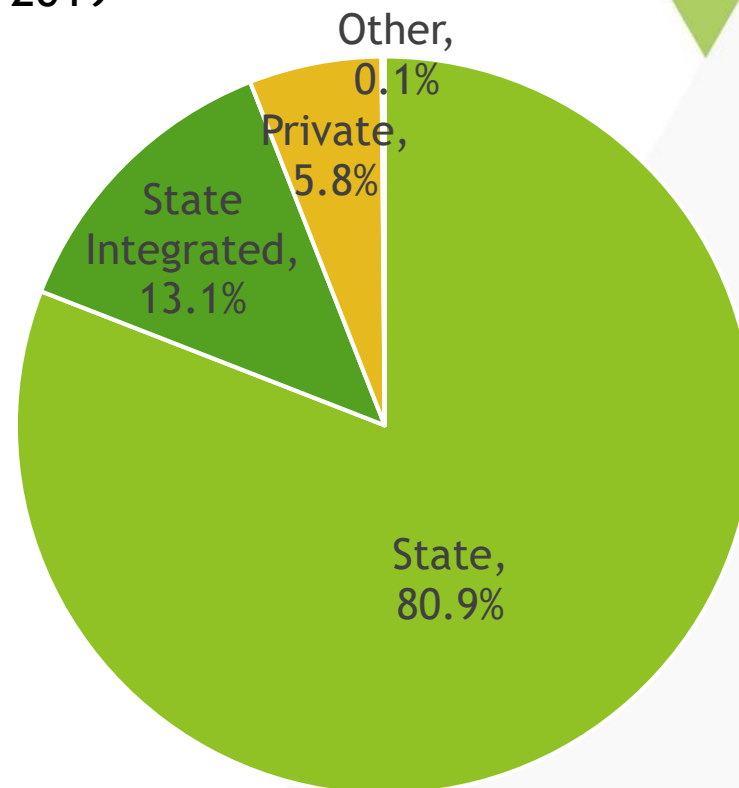
Greater Christchurch July rolls by Authority, 2010 and 2019 – all year levels

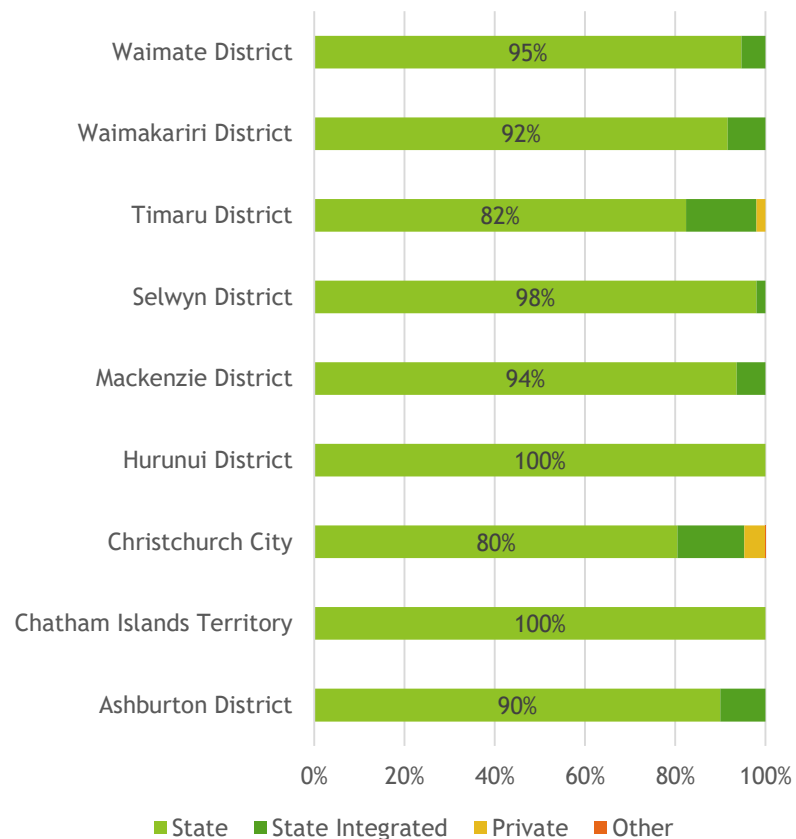

Greater Christchurch July rolls by Authority, 2010 and 2019 – Primary and Secondary

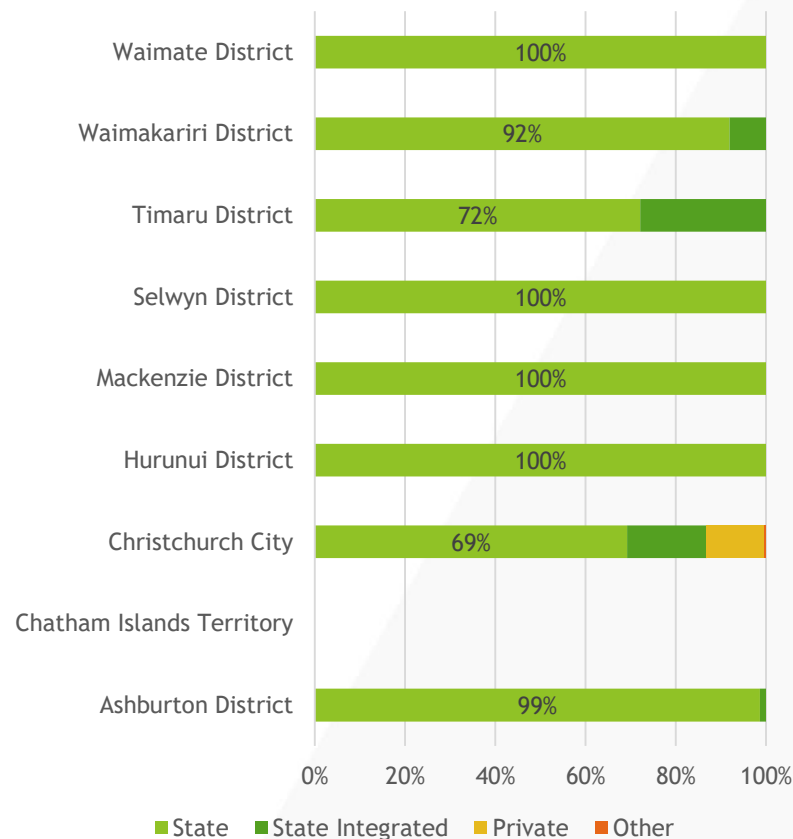


Canterbury July 2019 rolls by Authority and District – Primary and Secondary

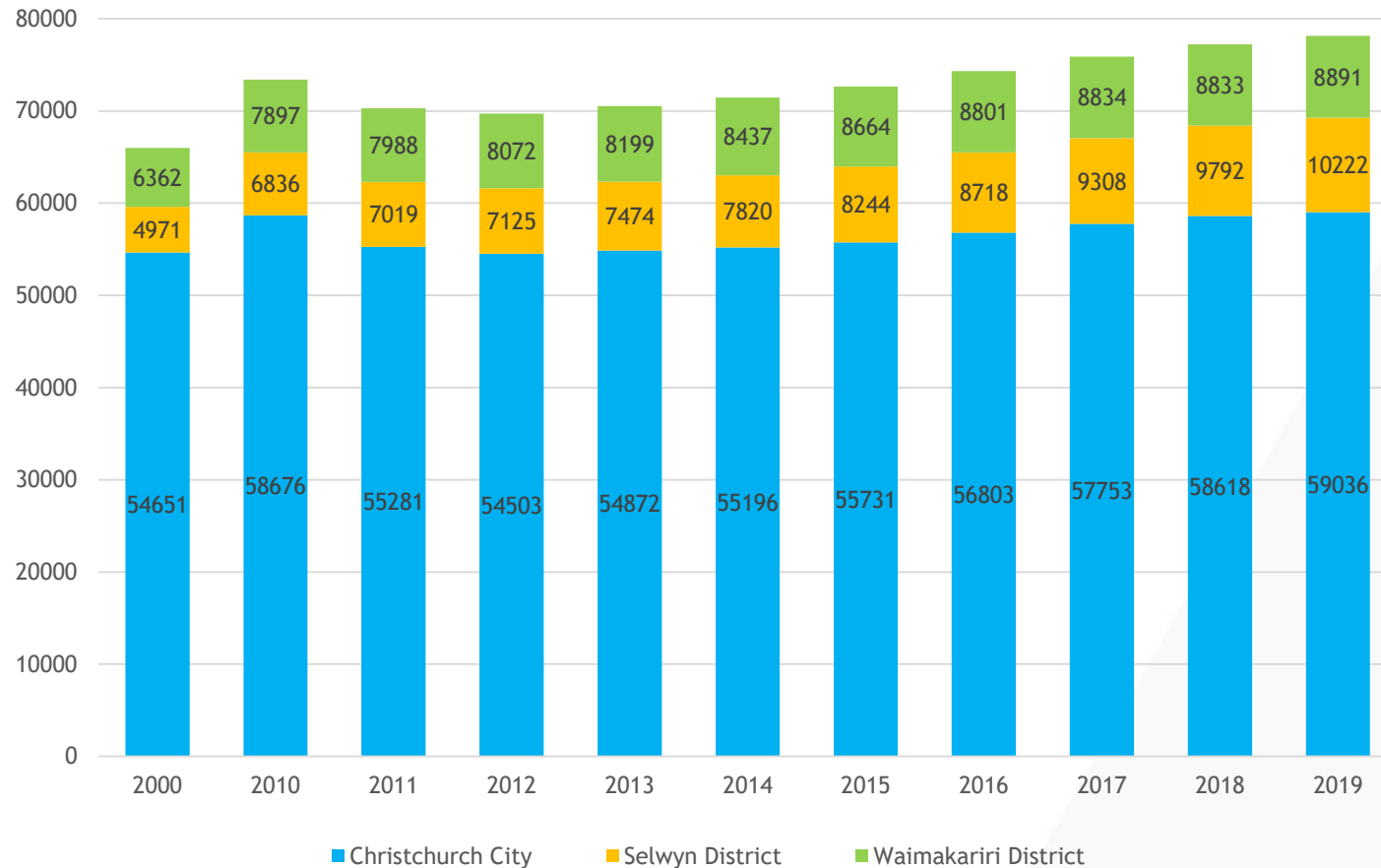

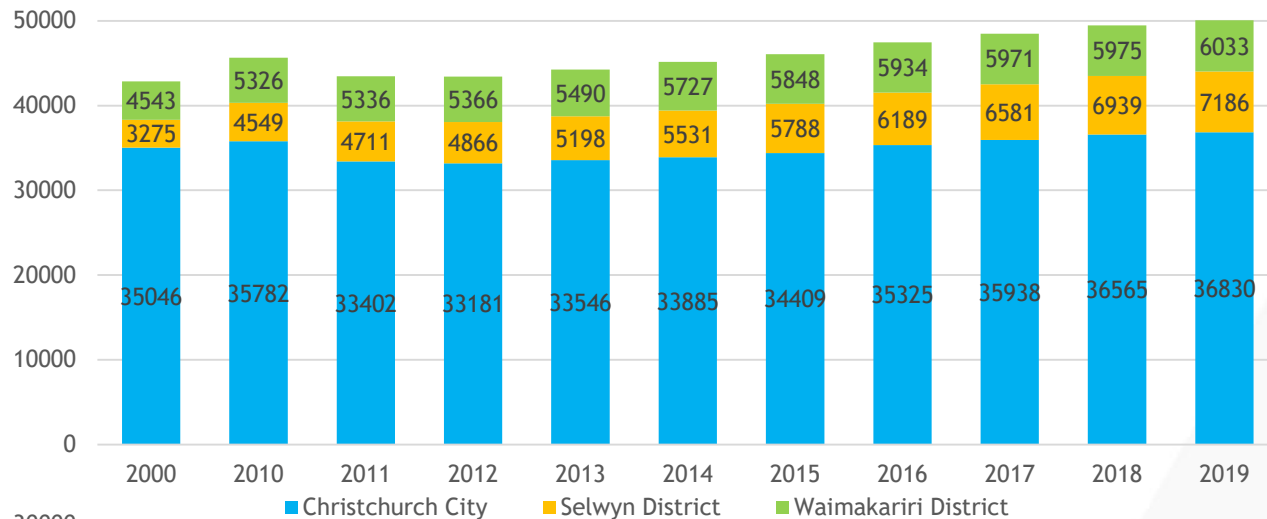
Greater Christchurch - School Rolls by District (all Authority types) – Total Year 1-15



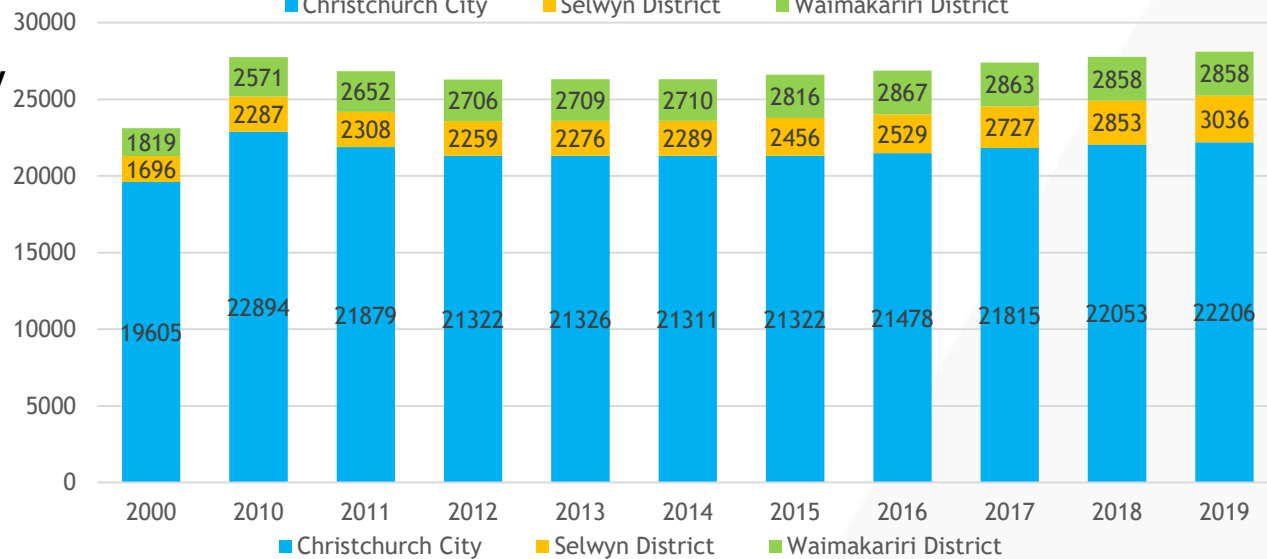

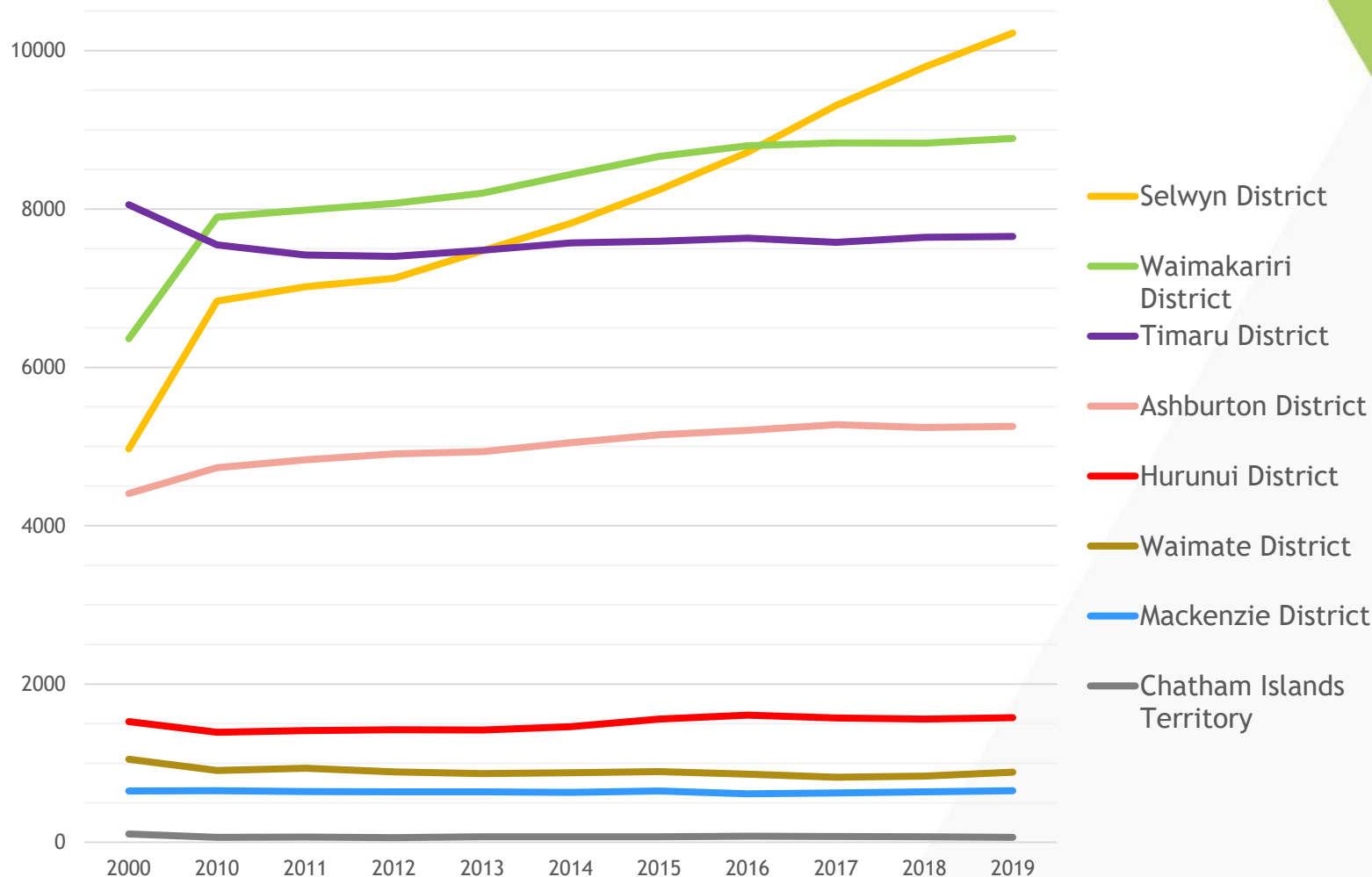

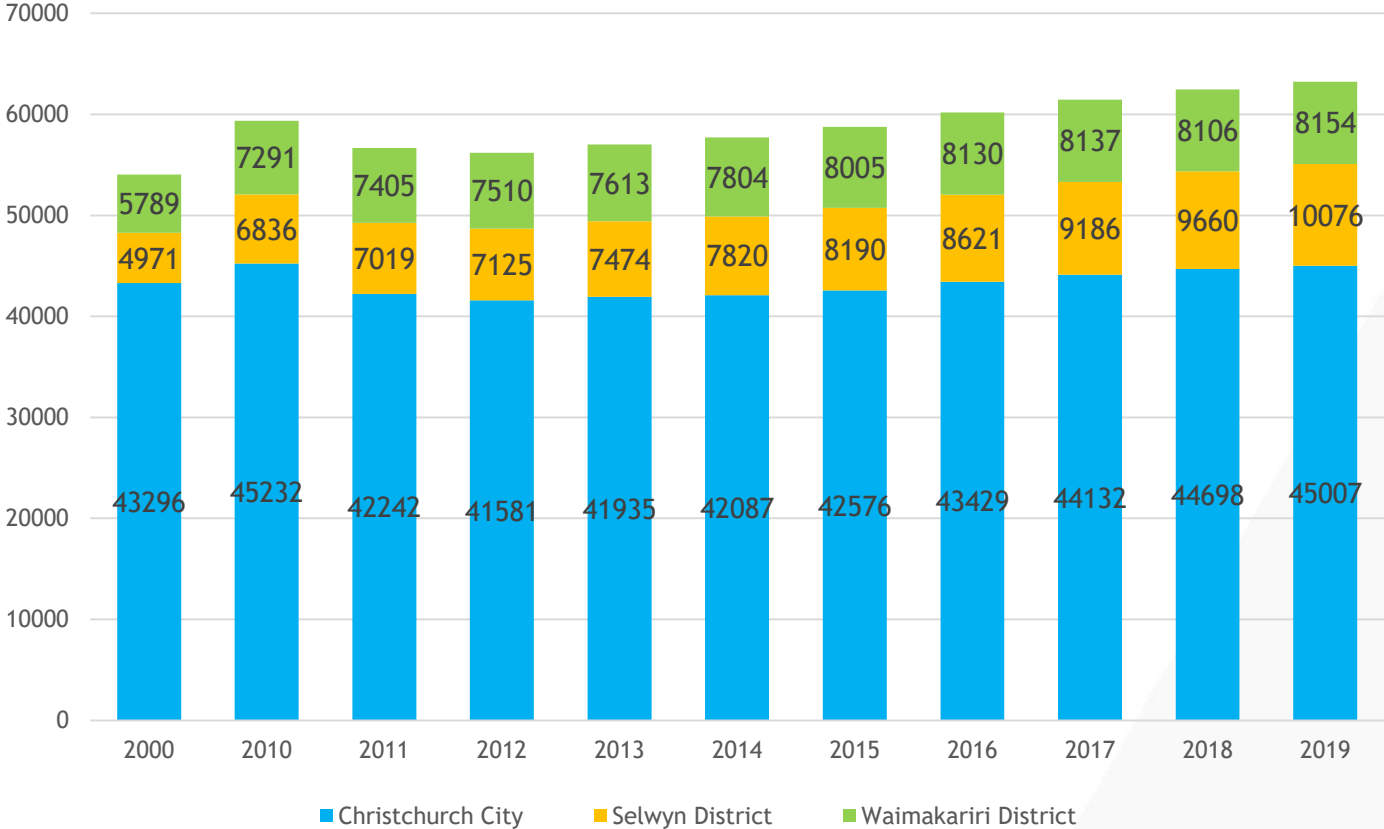

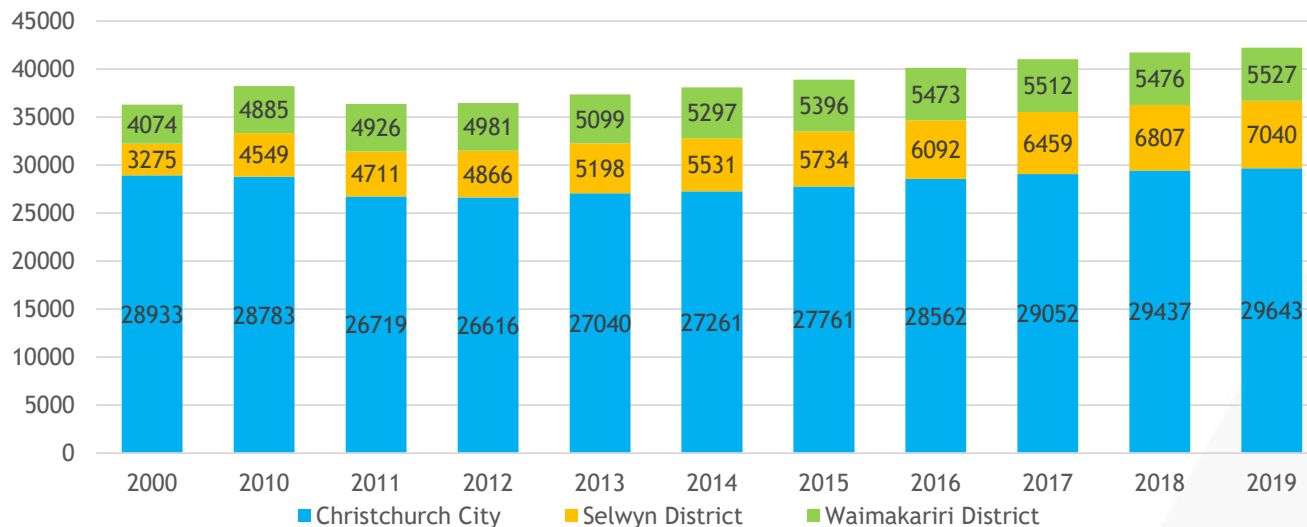
Greater Christchurch - State School Rolls by District – Total Year 1-15



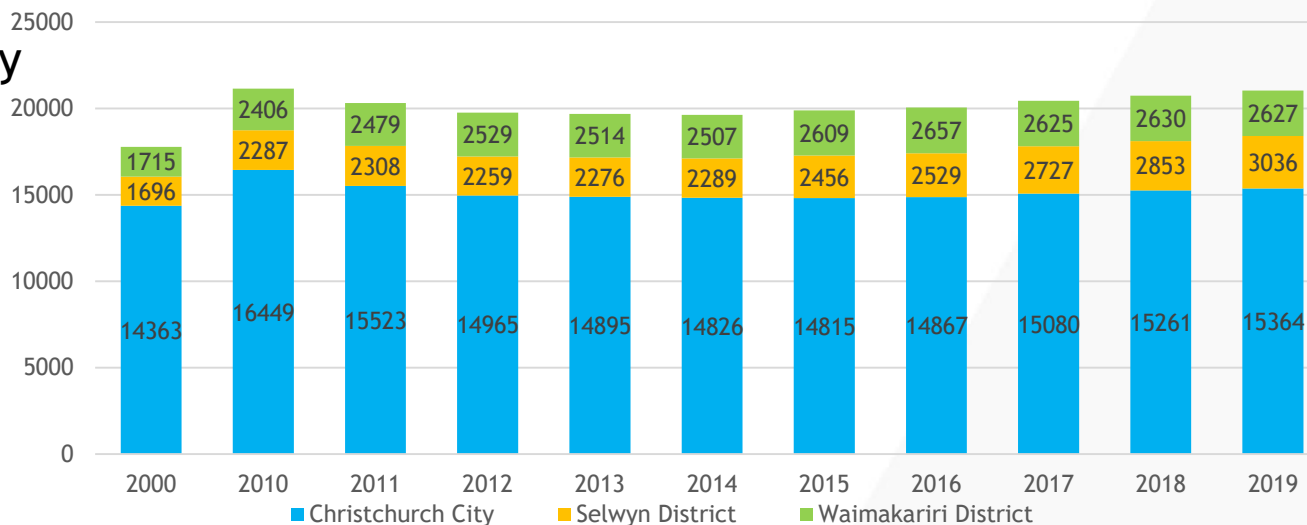

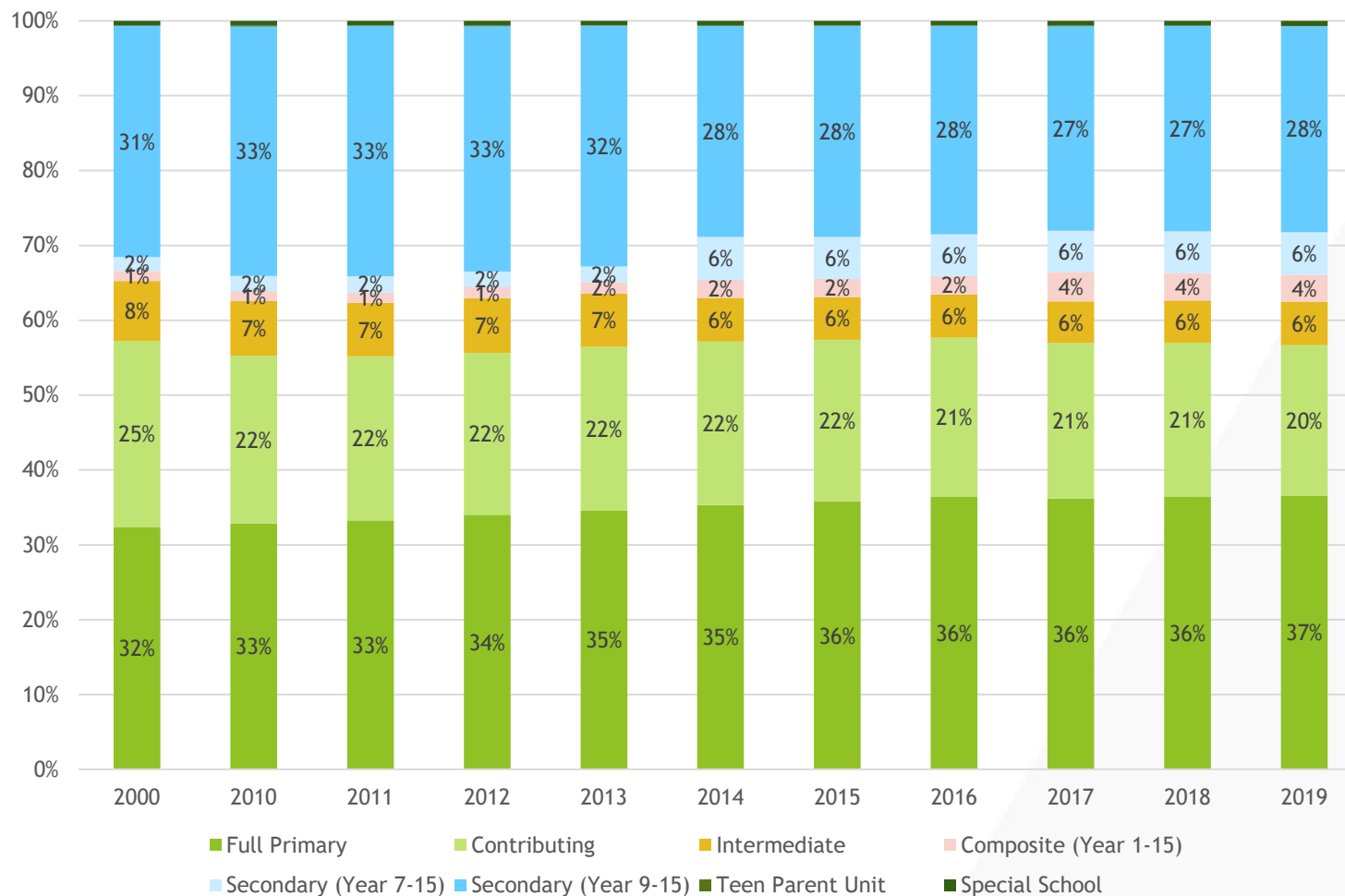

Greater Christchurch - State School Rolls by School Type – Proportion of Total State School Roll

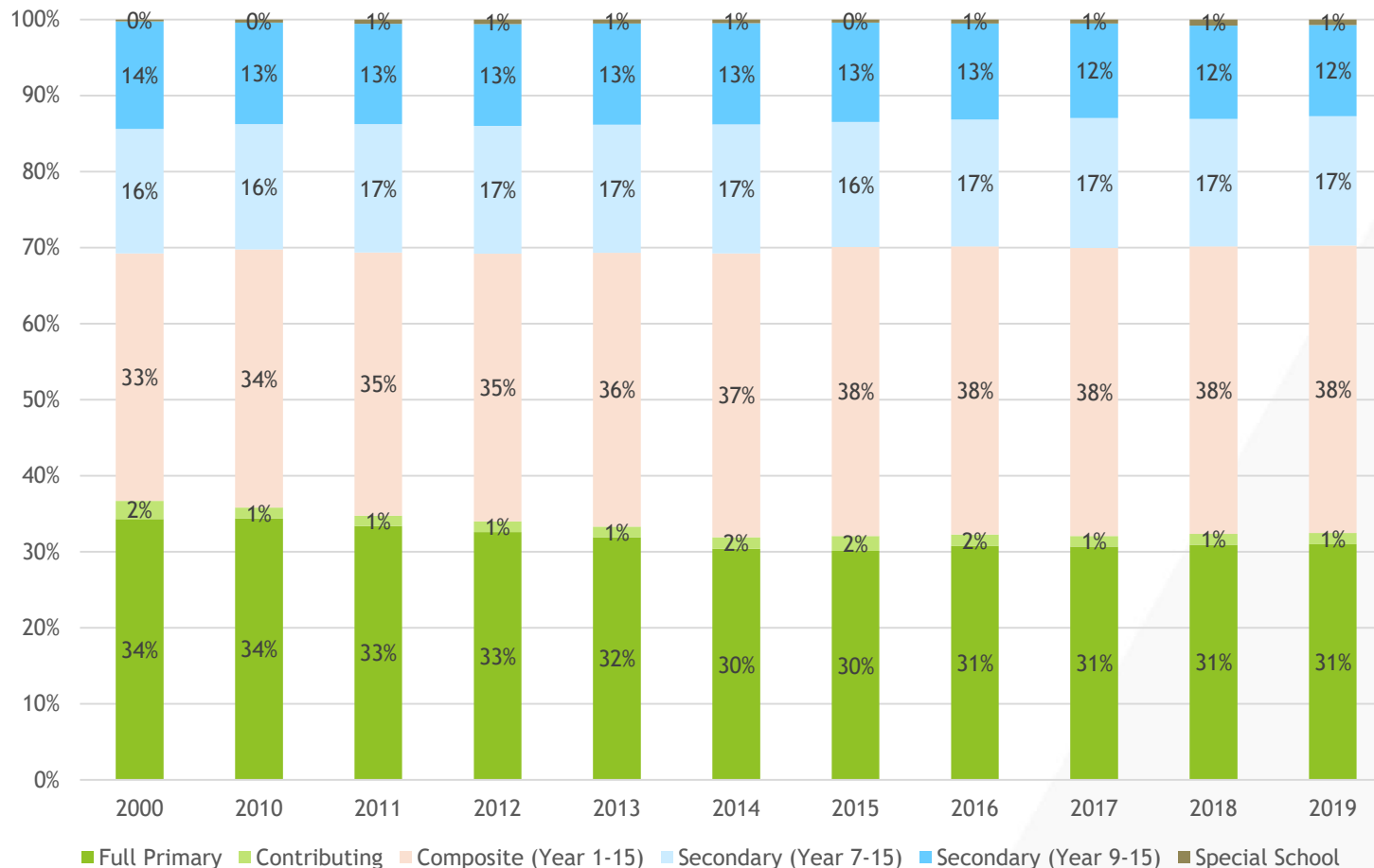

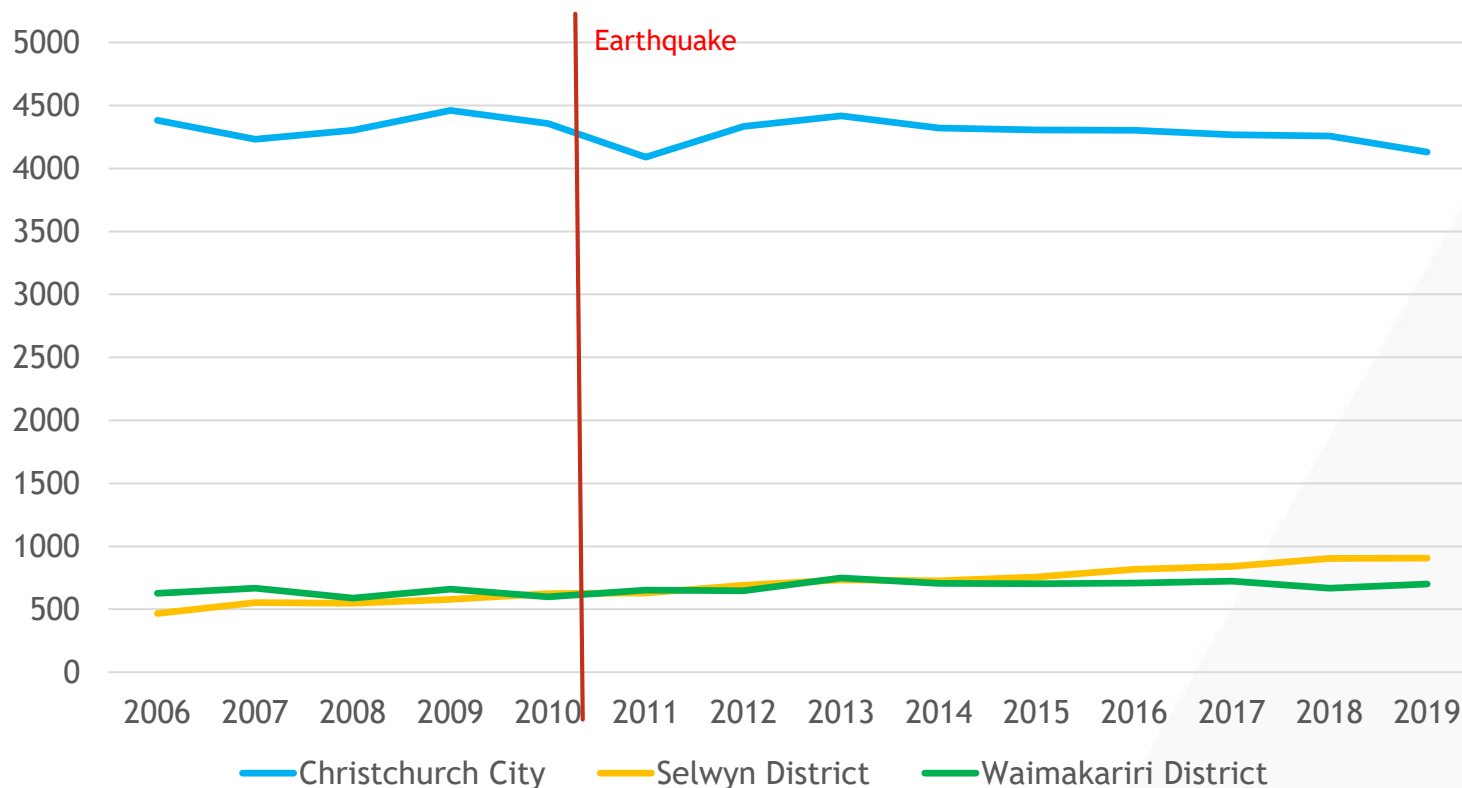

Year 1 Roll at Schools in Greater Christchurch by District, 2006-2019



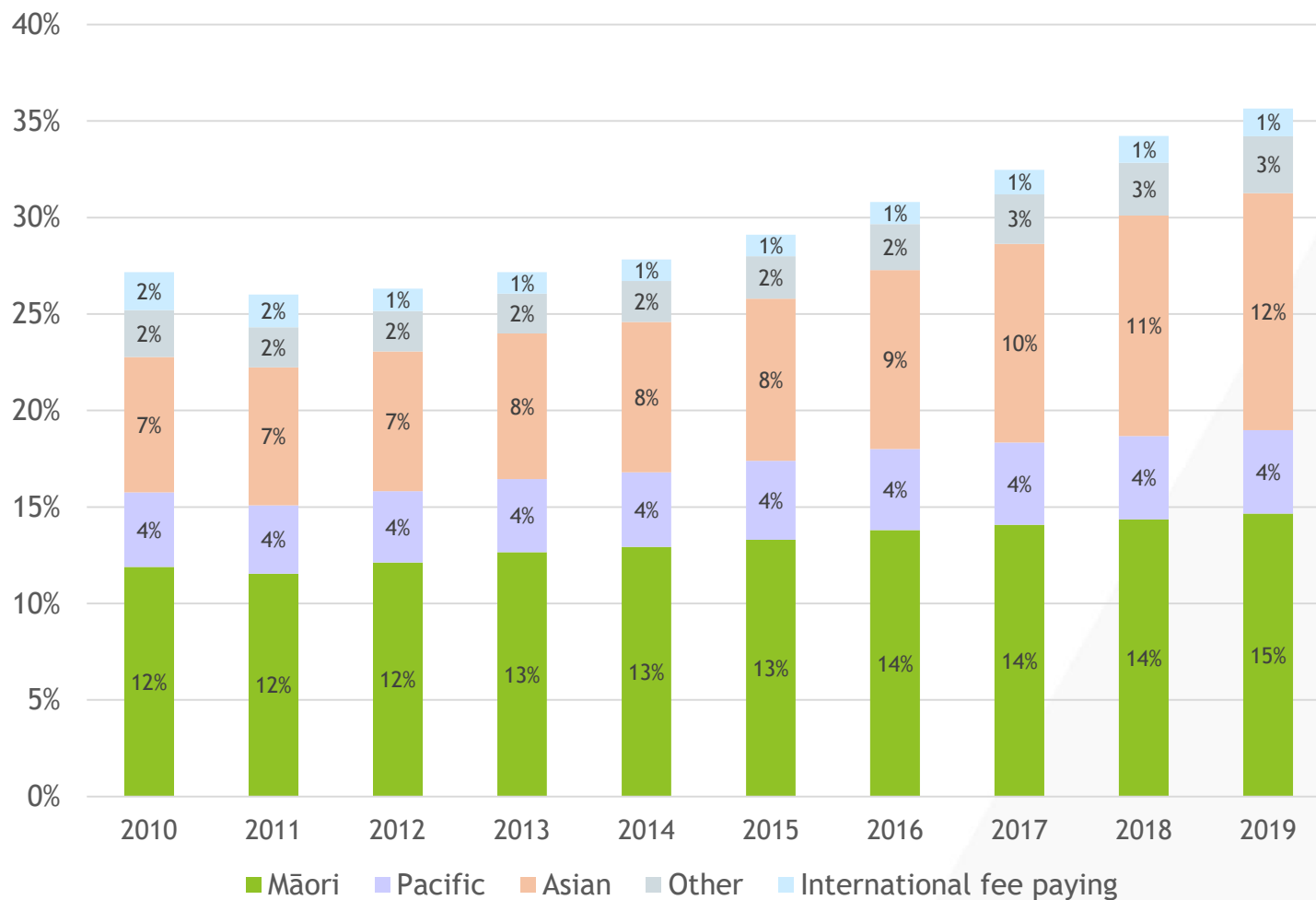
Provisional 2020 data indicates stability in Y1 rolls across each of the three regions. Note that, within each District, there are areas of growth and areas of decline.

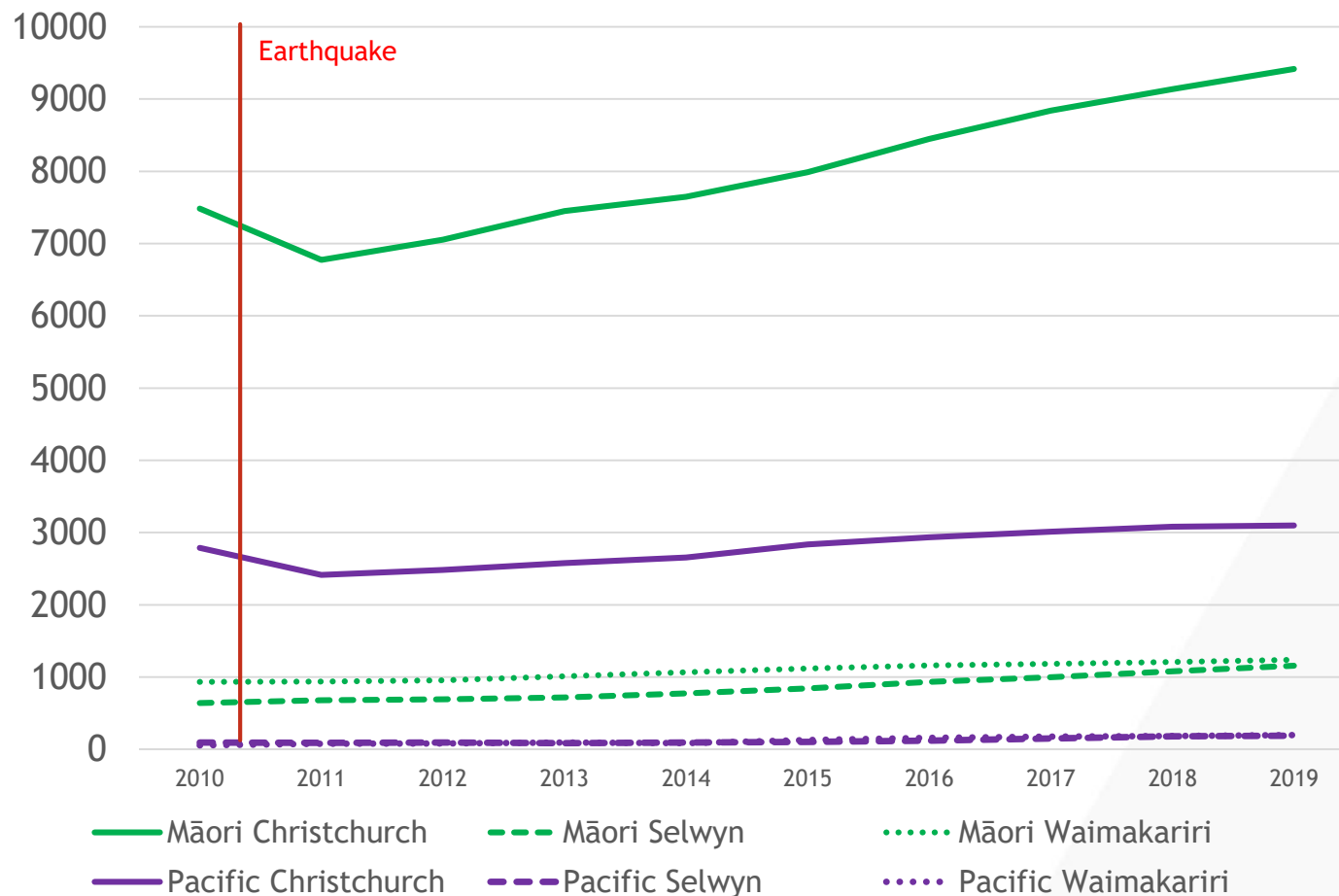

Non-European / Pākehā Ethnicities as proportion of total school roll in Greater Christchurch



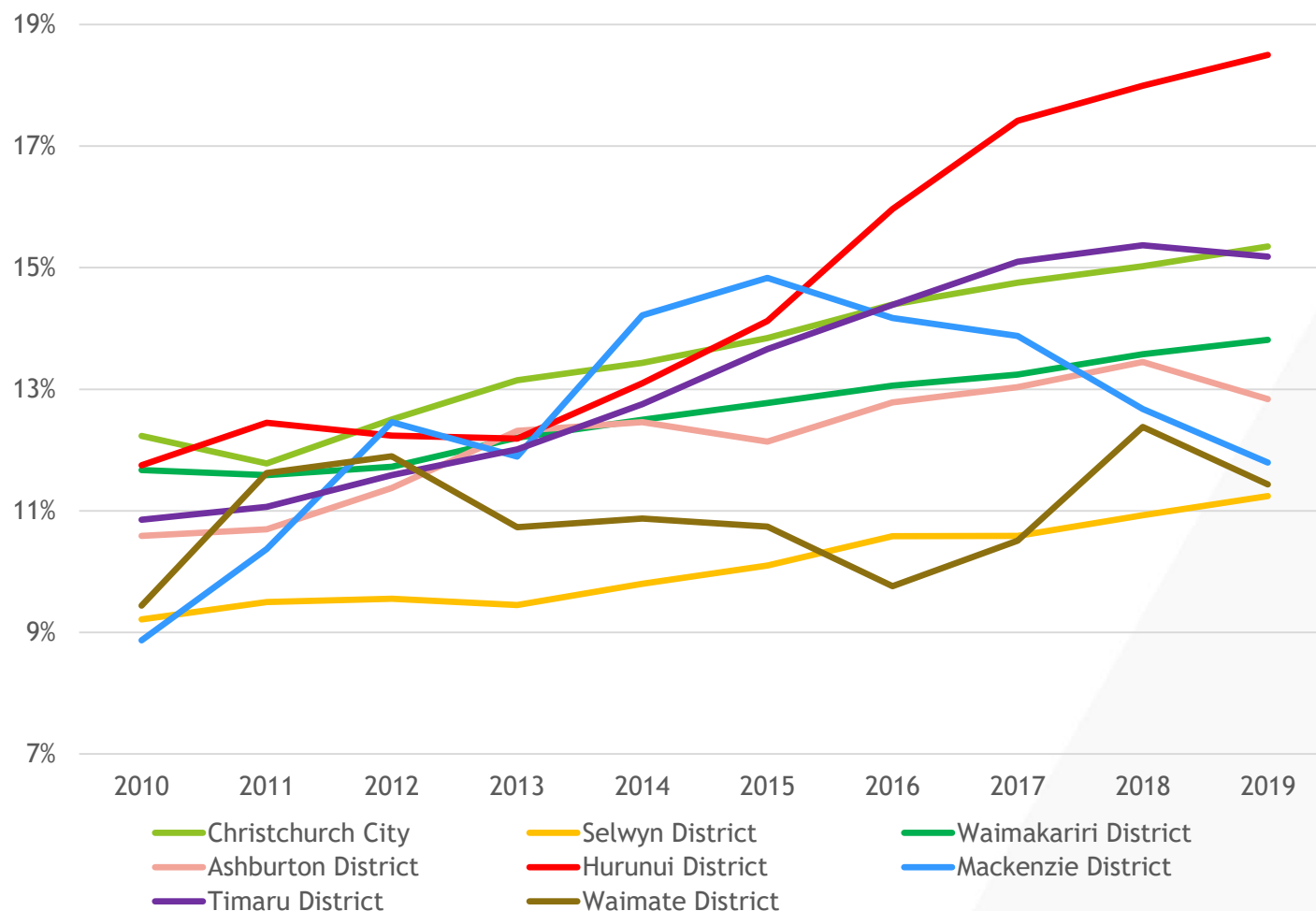

Māori and Pacific Rolls - Christchurch, Selwyn and Waimakariri Districts



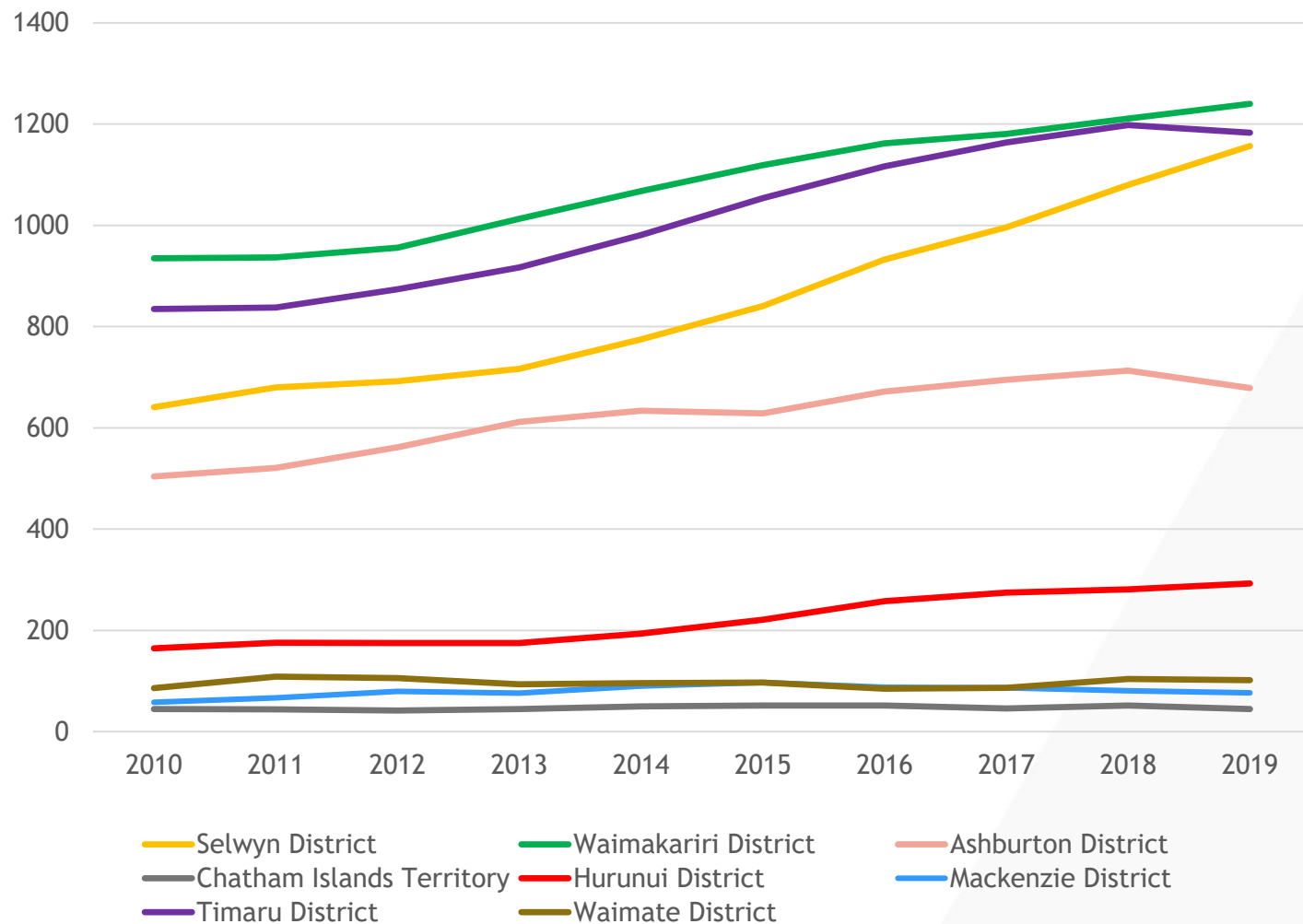

Māori % of total Roll across Canterbury



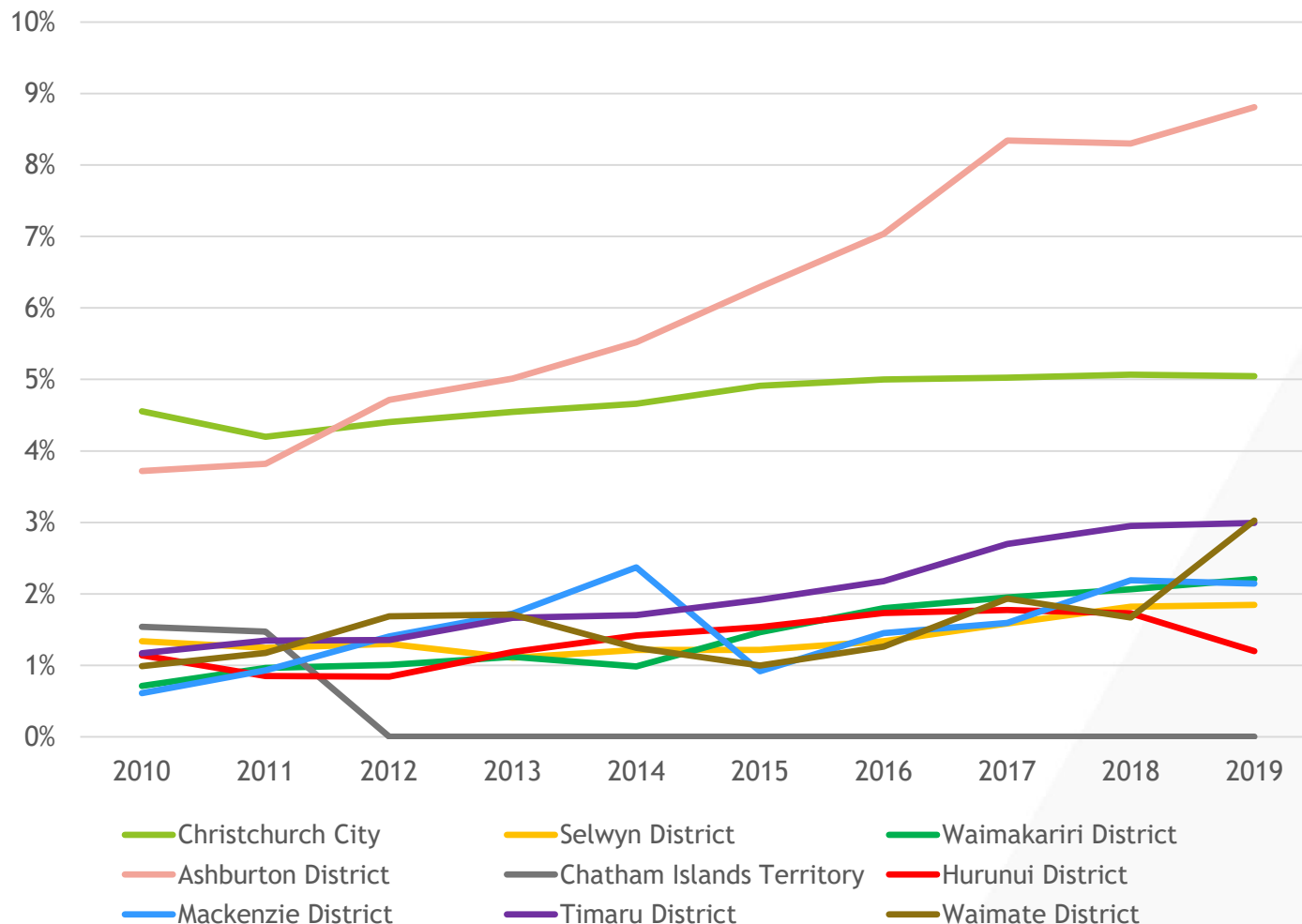

Māori Roll across Canterbury (excluding Christchurch)



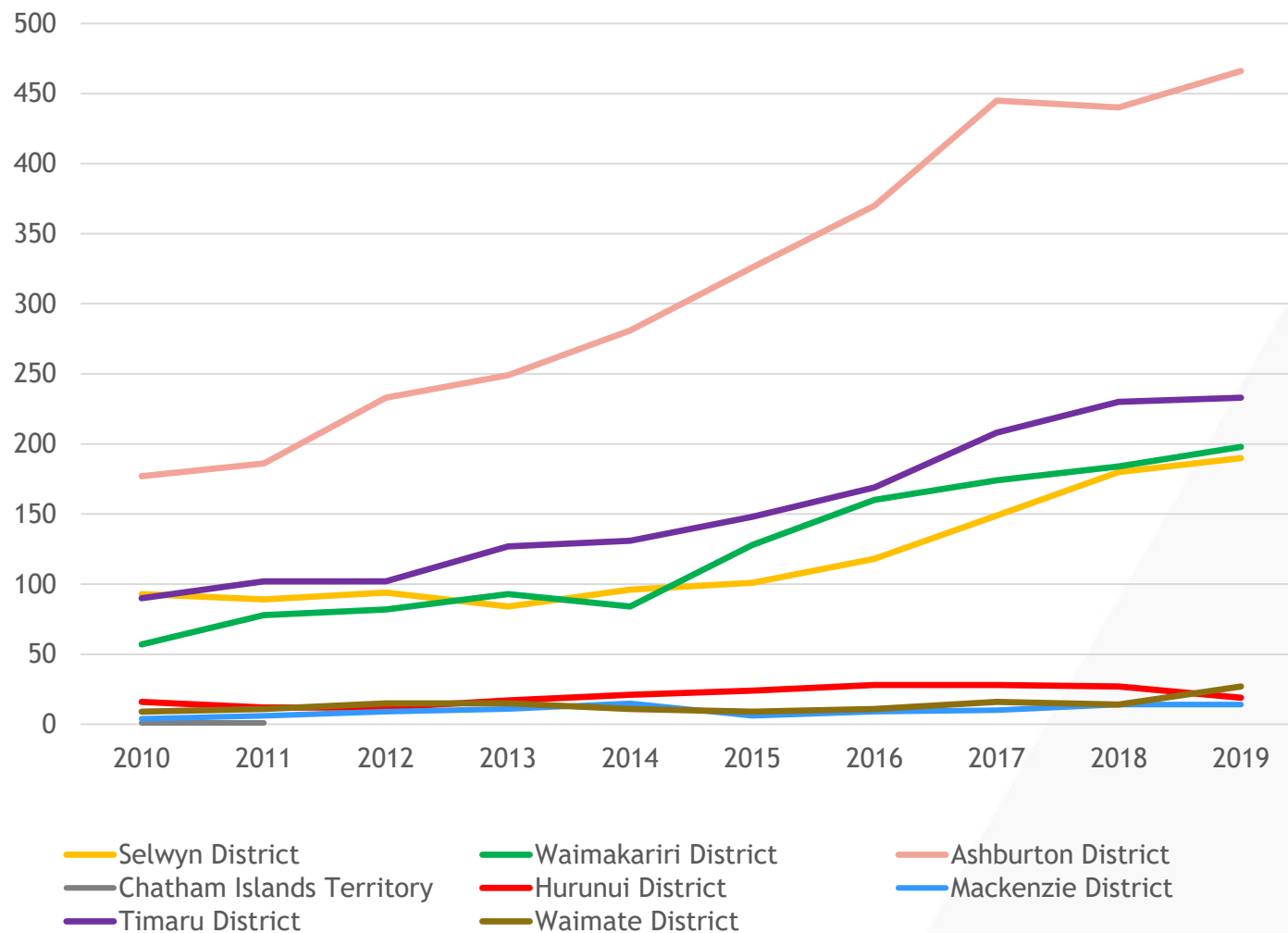
