

Population Change across Greater Christchurch

 - 2010 to 2020 (areas of recovery / sustained decline)

Note: “Greater Christchurch” refers to the combined Christchurch City, Selwyn and Waimakariri Districts.



Year 1-8 Population Change, 2010 to 2013

Change in Population





Year 1-8 Population Change, 2010 to 2020

Change in Population





Year 9-15 Population Change, 2010 to 2013






Canterbury July 2019 rolls by Authority and District – Primary and Secondary




Canterbury - State School Rolls by School Type – Proportion of State School Roll



Greater Christchurch - School Rolls by District (all Authority types) – Total Year 1-15








Canterbury Region - School Rolls by District (all Authority types) – Total Year 1-15 – Excluding Christchurch City


Canterbury Region - School Rolls by District (all Authority types) -Year 1-8 - Excluding Christchurch City

Year 1-6 rolls at schools in Canterbury as a percentage (by year level) of total Year 1-6 roll, 2000-2019




Across Canterbury, a population bubble is moving through the year levels. This varies between and within Districts.





Non-European / Pākehā Ethnicities as proportion of total school roll in Canterbury – 2010-2019




Non-European / Pākehā Ethnicities as proportion of total school roll in Canterbury – by District (2019)






Māori % of total Roll across Canterbury





Māori Roll across Canterbury (excluding Christchurch)




